You are hereby notified that you have been appointed a Commissioner to view, and if expedient to Vacate 2 county road 5 all petitioned by Charles David and others, and to be called the Rockwell & Montgomery

Roads described as follows:

Commencing at the a point on North side of Rockwell in Section 17th of Township 4th North of Range 2nd East of 5th W. Meridian, thence running N 64° E to center line of said Section 17th 34th - thence S on said line to the Rockwell intersection,

You will, therefore, appear before some officer authorized to administer oaths in and for said county, and qualify according to law; and on the 29th day of June 1877, you will proceed to commence the examination of the route above described, and if, in your judgment, the above road is needed, or one in the vicinity answering the same purpose, you will call to your assistance the necessary aid, and

make report to the Board on or before the 30th day of July 1877.

1. Your survey of this road you will particularly describe the point of commencement, with reference to some monument, natural or artificial, which will be generally found to consist of corners in the public and private surveys; the exact course and distance from some one of which you must refer in your field notes.

2. A point at which you terminate your survey must be ascertained and returned by reference to the same evidence as is herein required for the commencing point.

3. All lines and figures inscribed upon wood, must be cut with a marking iron, similar to that used in the Government survey of lands.

4. Where bearing trees are taken, and it is strongly enjoined that they should without fail be tagged, a smooth face fronting the angle of the road, should be made as near as practicable, and in this face should be cut the initials of the beginning and ending of the road. For example—a road from Delhi to Colony—D. & C. R. W. and in this face should be cut the initials of the beginning and ending of the road.

5. Marks in timber will consist of an incision in the bark, and where this is impracticable, a large mound of earth should be raised at the point of the angle.

6. After completing the crossing of fences and streams, and at intervals in the prairie not exceeding one-fourth of a mile each, the distance marked thereon, —

7. All your instructions in no way relieve you from each and every duty prescribed by the laws of Iowa Revision of 1880, pages 124 and 125.
