You are hereby notified that you have been appointed a Commissioner to view, and if expedient to locate county road at petitioned by John A. Patton and others, and to be called the Patton

Road, described as follows:

Commencing ~~at~~ the line between Black Hawk & Benton townships at a point eighty (80) rods West of the South East corner of Section 19, Township 36 N. Range 10 E. City & Town (87) North of Range 10 E. Section (12) West of the 5th Mer. Thence running North 1/4th of a mile to the West of La Porte City

You will, therefore, appear before some officer authorized to administer oaths in and for said county, and qualify according to law; and on the 7th day of Sept 1877, you will proceed to commence the examination of the route above described, and if, in your judgment, the above road is needed, or one in the vicinity answering the same purpose, you will call to your assistance the necessary aid, and proceed to lay out and mark the same according to law and the following instructions, and report to the Board on or before the 7th day of Oct 1877.

1. In your survey of this road you will particularly describe the point of commencement, with reference to some monument, record, which will be generally found to consist of corners in the public and private surveys; the exact course and distance from some one of which you must give in your field notes.
2. The point at which you terminate your survey must be ascertained and returned by reference to the same evidence as is herein required for the commencing point.
3. All letters and figures inscribed upon wood, must be cut with a "trunking iron," similar to that used in the Government survey of lands. The angle of the point, should be made as near the ground as practicable, and in this case should be cut the initial letters of the pointed, beginning and ending of the road. For example:—a road from Delhi to Colony—D. & C. E. When bearing trees cannot be had at angles, it is recommended the pointing and ending of to a boulder, edifice, or corner of an enclosure be taken, and where this is impracticable, a large mound of earth should be raised at the point of the angle.
5. Marks in the form of a smith's "blaze," and that upon which it leaves such trees. Little posts must be set up at every mile, and the distance marked thereon.—Stakes must be set at the crossing of fences and streams, and at intervals must be set up at every mile, and the distance marked thereon.—
6. After completing your survey of this road, you must carefully protect the same upon paper, with a view to the detection of all errors, either in your chaining or course.
7. These instructions in no way relieve you from each and every duty prescribed by the laws of Iowa Revision of 1860, pages 124 and 125.
8. All your assistants are required to be sworn by some person authorized to administer oaths.

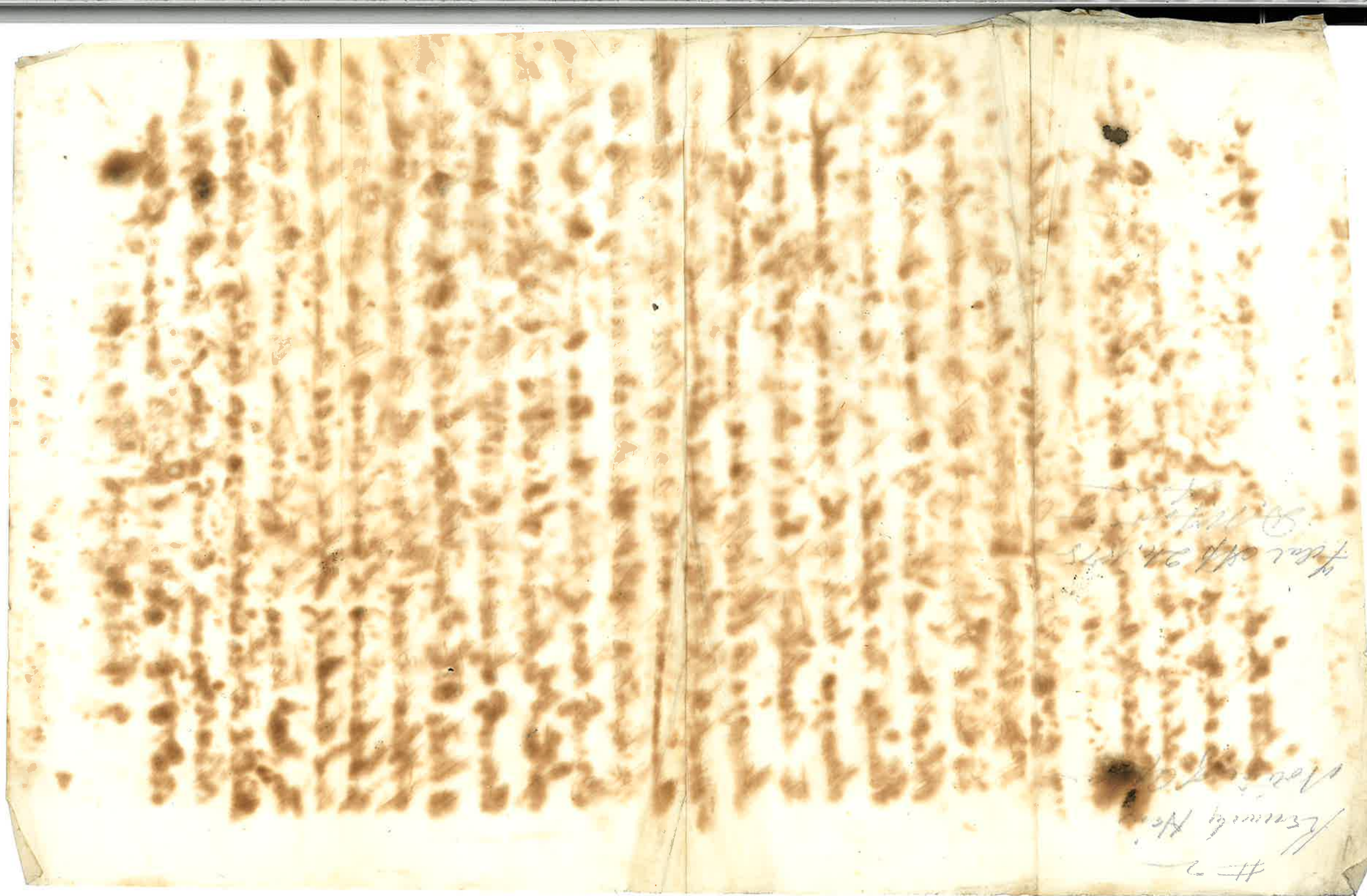
