That, having been duly sworn, he found, upon examination, that it was necessary for the accommodation of the public, that the road should be changed as petitioned for.

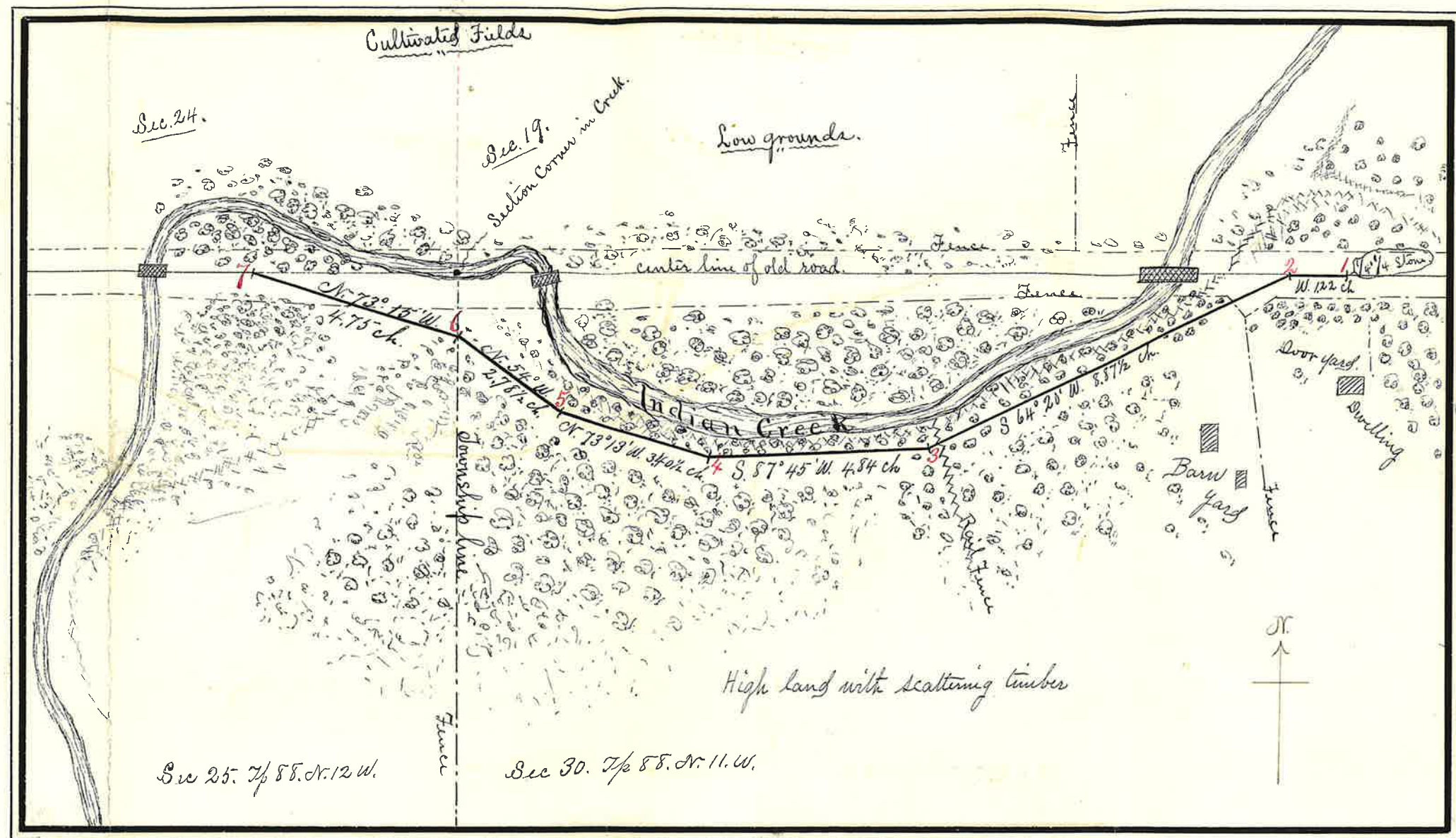
