Field Notes of Trinch Road.

Commenced at the southwest corner of Section 6. 76° 90.0' Range 14th. Black Hawk County. Iowa, thence on the line of old road on County line between Black Hawk and Pottawattamie. North. 5-50 chs to angle & stake. Thence DN 87° E. 45-29 chs to angle & stake, which is 82 the short work from West End of Sand Bridge across at Shells Rock. Thence S 46° E. 3-26 chs passing over the said bridge to angle on the prominent approach to said bridge - Thence South 5-17 chs to angle & stone probably at intersection of ditches. & the village of Trichyng. Thence. West 3-70 chs to the South 1/4 corner line of said Section 6. 76° 90. N. 14 west.
