



County Court of said county, to appoint a commissioner to view and locate a county road, called
The Blawell Ha wke Road
undersigned shall pay all costs arising
Now, if the said road shall be established according to law, and the same become a public
highway, in accordance with the statute in such cases made and provided, then this obligation to be
void: otherwise, to be and remain in full force and virtue.

A Petition will be presented to the County Court of Black Hawk Coⁿ by State of Iowa, at the February Term, 1856 for the appointment of a Commissioner to find and report the expediency of a road over the following route To wit

Commencing on the east bank of Black Hawk Creek at a point west of the 44 post of Section No 33 in Township 89 north of Range 13 west in said County. Thence running east through the center of Sections 33 & 34 until it intersects the Waterloo & Hardin City Road

to be called the Black Hawk Road,
