You are hereby notified that you have been appointed a Commissioner to view, and if expedient to locate county road as petitioned by M. A. Summers and others, and to be called the Hayes

Road, described as follows:

Commencing at the State Road on the North line of Section No 1 in Township No 87, Range No 12, West 5th Mer. - Thence running West as Section line to the N.W. corner of said Section No 1, 87.12 - Thence South as line between Section 1 & 2 and 11 & 12 - 87-12 - to the S.W. corner of Sec No 12, 87.12 - Thence an line between Secs 12 & 13 to the about three fourths of a mile to intersect the public road

You will, therefore, appear before some officer authorized to administer oaths in and for said county, and qualify according to law; and on the 26th day of May 1883, you will proceed to commence the examination of the route above described, and if, in your judgment, the above road is needed, or one in the vicinity answering the same purpose, you will call to your assistance the necessary aid, and proceed to lay out and mark the same according to law and the following instructions, and report to the Board on or before the 26th day of May 1883.

1. In your survey of this road you will particularly describe the point of commencement, with reference to some monument record, which will be generally found to consist of corners in the public and private surveys; the exact course and distance from some one of which you must give in your field notes.
2. The point at which you terminate your survey must be ascertained and returned by reference to the same evidence as is herein required for the commencement point.
3. All letters and figures inscribed upon wood, must be cut with a "punching iron," similar to that used in the Government survey of lands.
4. When bearing trees are taken, and it is strongly recommended that if without the aid of the State Surveyor, they should without fail be taken with both face fronting the road. For example a road from Delhi to Colfax - D & C R. When bearing trees cannot be had at angles it is recommended the bearing and distance to a boulder, edifice, or corner of an enclosure be taken, and where this is impracticable a large mound of earth should be raised at the point of the angle.
5. Marks in timber will consist of a smith's "blaze," with a notch in the centre, except the trees with the line cuts, each of which must have three notches, both upon the side which the line strikes, and that upon which it leaves such trees. Mile posts must be set up at every mile, and the distance marked thereon.
6. After completing your survey of this road, you must carefully protract the same upon paper, with a view to the detection of all errors, either in your chaining or course.
7. These instructions in no way relieve you from each and every duty prescribed by the laws of Iowa Revision of 1880, pages 134 and 135.
8. All your assistants are required to be sworn by some person authorized to administer oaths.
