a road described in the foregoing commission, respectfully reports:

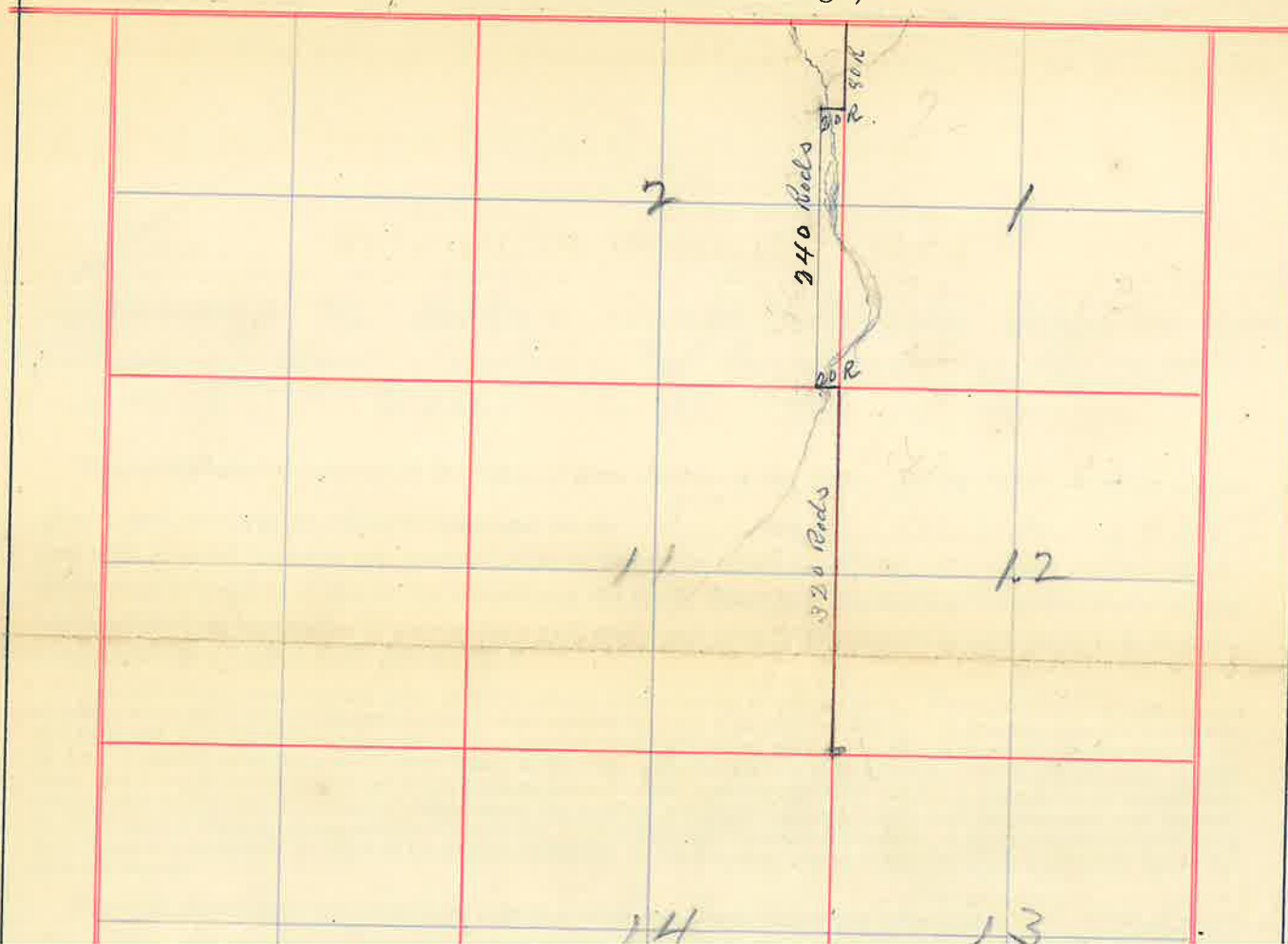

You are hereby notified, that you have been appointed a Commissioner to view, and, if required, to locate a County Road, petitioned for by John Kirchner, Esq. and others, and described as follows, to-wit:

Commencing at the North line between Sections 1 & 2, Twp. 89, Range 12,
and running thence South one hundred and sixty rods, thence West twenty (20) Rods, thence South one hundred and sixty (160) Rods, thence East twenty (20) Rods, thence one (1) mile South between Sections 11 & 12.

and terminating at the Section corner between Sections Nos. Eleven, Twelve, Thirteen and Fourteen, (11, 12, 13, & 14) of Township No Eighty nine (89), Range Twelve, (12).

You will therefore appear at the office of some Justice of the Peace, Notary Public, or other proper officer, and qualify according to law, and on the 5th day of April A. D. 1888, you will proceed to make an examination of the route above described.
