North, Range Number Thirteen (13), West 5th P.M.:
Thence North West to a point about Township (20) Road
West of the North East corner of the South half of the
North West Quarter of Section Number Twenty-Two (22)
in said Township and Range: Thence due West to, and
across, the Burlington, Cedar Rapids and Northern Rail Road:
Thence North West on the South West side of said
Rail Road right of way to a point at or near the
North East corner of the South West Quarter of the South
West Quarter of Section Number Sixteen (16) in said
Township and Range: Thence West to the North East
corner of the South West Quarter of the South West Quarter
of Section Number Seventeen (17) in said Township
and Range: Thence North West to the North West
corner of the North East Quarter of the North East Quarter
of the South East Quarter of Section Number Eighteen (18)
in said Township and Range: Thence West to the Highway
already established to Cedar Falls, in Black Hawk County,

Official Bond.

Know all men by these Presents, that we, David Johnson and Lucinda Johnson, J. N. Briggs

of the County of Black Hawk, are held and firmly bound unto said County in the penal sum of One Hundred Dollars (\$100.), lawful money of the United States of America, for the payment of which sum we bind ourselves and legal representatives jointly by these presents. The condition of the above obligation is such that the above bondsmen have filed their petition asking for the establishment of a highway between the cities of Waterloo and Cedar Falls in said County.

And if the said bondsmen shall pay all expense growing out of such application in case the contemplated highway is not finally established, this Bond is to void: otherwise in full force.
