We the undersigned Trustees
of Paymer Township Blackhawk County
Iowa having been anxious to know where
the County or State Road was located so
that the Road Supervisor could work
on said Road from Indian Creek to the
Main Street in the Village of Gilbertville
& in forming the Records of said original
Survey of said Road we found them very
deficient & said notes did not run one half
of the distance of said Route & where it did
run no body could travel & as the Road
had never been on the place where the notes
pointed out. We there on the 26th of Oct
1889 made a Survey of that part of said
Road we commenced on East Side of the Bridge
built on Indian Creek near where the Road
is now made & ran across the center of said
Bridge & ran the Road (the center) very near
the center of the old traveled Road the first
part Particular the latter part a little Easterly
of said center of old traveled Road so as to
keep said Road off of the low bottom we made
the Road 4 Roads wide & have set stakes &
stones in center of Road & have set stakes
at each angle 2 Rods distance
