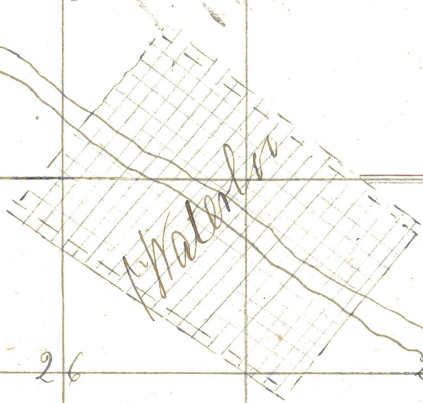

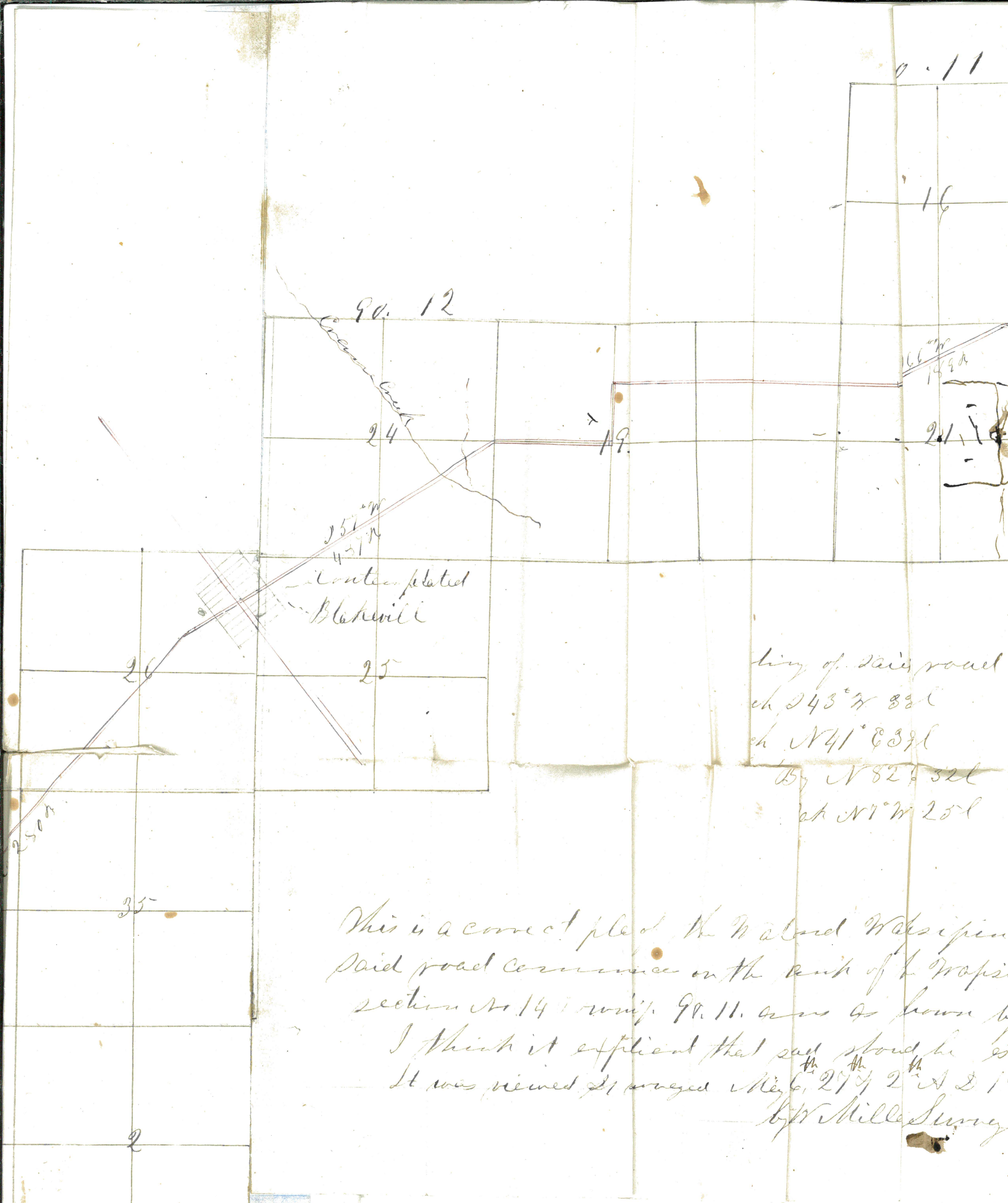
Wabigoon to Independence road

Cedar River

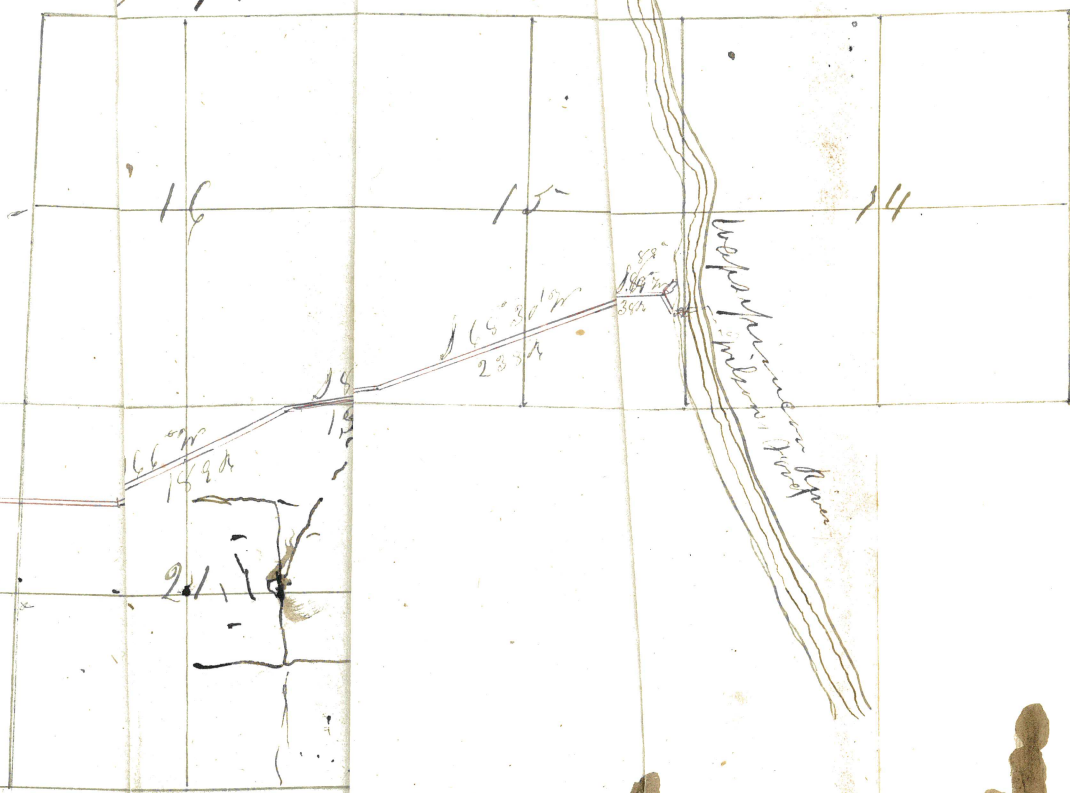

and that such notices contained
the principal points through which
said road was to pass, and the time
at which application would be
made to the County Court for the appoin-
-tment of a commissioner to examine
report upon the same

KNOW ALL MEN, by these Presents, That we, John Clabine
and Ephraim Shaffer
 of the county of Bluer Hawk, and State of Iowa, are held and firmly bound unto the county
 of Shoerbrook in the sum of Two hundred Dollars
 for the payment of which, well and truly to be made, we bind ourselves, our heirs, executors, ad
 ministrators, and every of them, firmly, by these presents.

The Condition of the above Obligation is such, That, whereas John
Clabine & Ephraim Shaffer has this day made application, by petition, to the
 County Court of said county, to appoint a commissioner to view and locate a county road, called
Waterloo & Wapsiegan Road & also ^{get in of} a Road
across Wapsiegan

Now, if the said road shall be established according to law, and the same become a public
 highway, in accordance with the statute in such cases made and provided, then this obligation to be
 void: otherwise, to be and remain in full force and virtue.
