Whereas it is proposed to lay out and establish
a County road to be described as follows
Commencing in the Center of Locust street
in Leavitt's addition to Volusia town at a
point ⁻¹³²⁹⁻ 1329 feet north westerly from Center of old
street in Volusia town, thence ⁽⁸²⁵⁾ running west & north
thence ⁻⁶⁰⁻ Commencing gate, to be 60 feet wide,
thence Commencing 40 ft. East of said
Cemetery gate and ⁽⁸⁰⁾ running south 77 feet
and to be 80 feet in width. and to be across
the Unimproved Cemetery road, which said road
passes over premises belonging to us,
we therefore know all men by these presents
that we the undersigned for value received do hereby
Consent that said road passing over land belonging
to us over which it is proposed said road shall
pass, be used for that purpose and for hereby
release all claims to damages by reason of the
laying out and opening of said road.

 Addition to Waterloo. 1329 feet North West
 from the Center of the Waterloo and Eldon road
 Thence West 82.5 feet to center fork of the Elmwood
 cemetery gate to have a width of sixty feet. (The line
 above described is the center line of said road -)
 Thence beginning at a point forty (40) feet east
