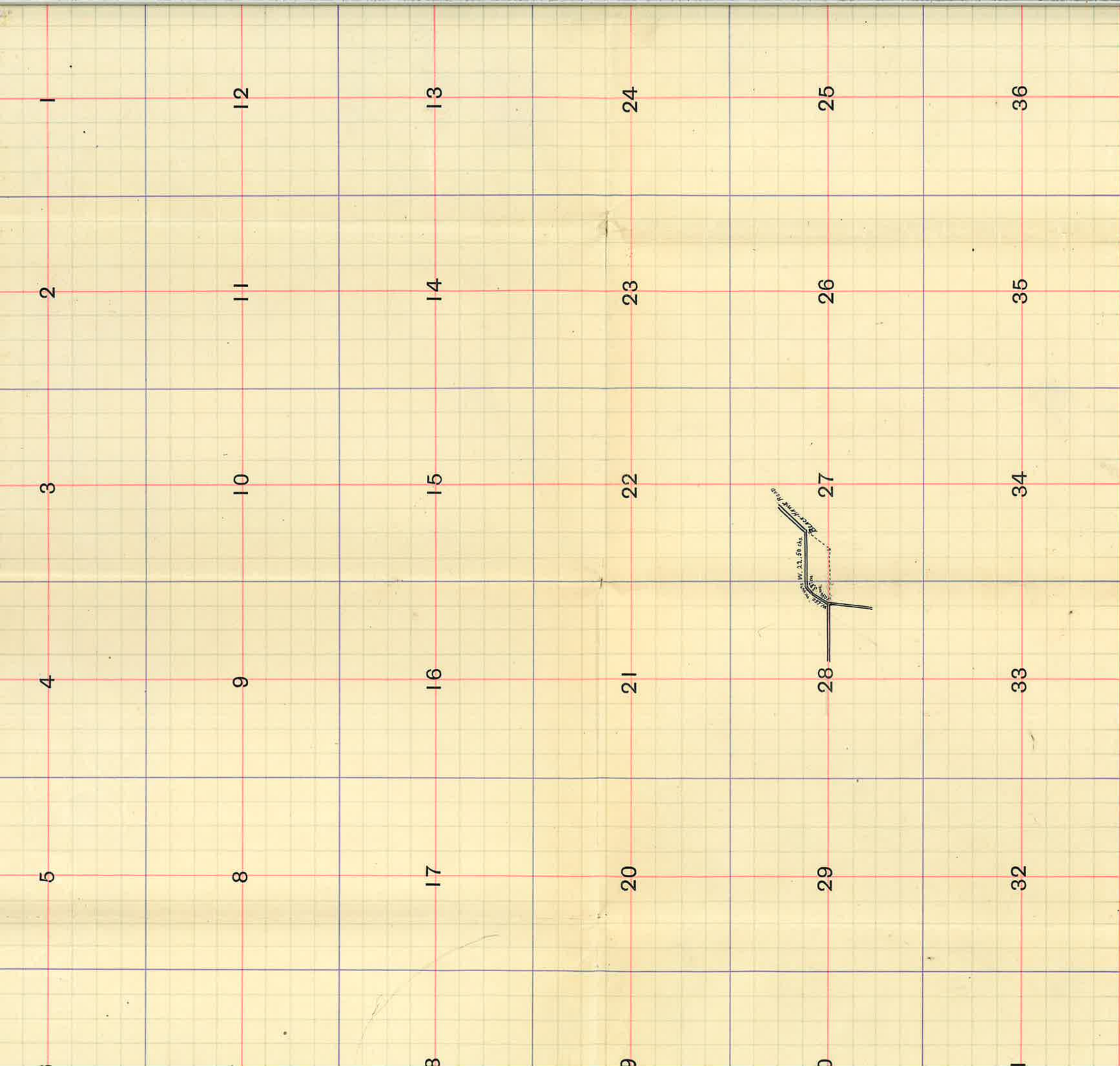


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Change in Black Bank
Creek Road
Waterloo Pups



Commencing at a point in the center of the present Black-Hawk road in sec. 13, T. 89, Range 13, 25 links south and 15 links east of the N.E. cor. of S.E. $\frac{1}{4}$ of sec. 27. Thence running West 22.50 chains. Thence running W. 44° S. 3.87 chains. Thence running 10.46 chains, to a point where it again meets the Black-Hawk road, and where the road makes a junction with the road running West.

ROAD PETITION.

To the Board of Supervisors of Black Hawk County, Iowa:

The undersigned ask that a Highway, commencing at the Black Hawk Road intersects the East line of the North West-Quarter of the North West-Quarter of Section No. 27 Township No. 89, Range No. 13 and running thence Southwesterly and Westerly along said Black Hawk Road to the point where said Road turns and runs Southwesterly on the South half of the North East Quarter of Section No. 28, said Township and Range,

and terminating at said point-
