The undersigned respectfully petition that a Highway Forty feet wide, commencing at a corner turn (20) feet West of the South West corner of the South east quarter of the South east quarter of Section Number Six (5) in Township Number Ninety (90), North of Range Number Fourteen (14) West of the Fifth Principal Meridian and running thence North down (7) Rods thence North 45° East about twenty eight + 28 feet to the line between the East half of the South east quarter and the West half of the South west quarter of said Section Number Six (5) thence North on said line about Eighty one (81) Rods and thence (13) feet and terminating at the North east corner of the South East quarter of the North west quarter of the South East quarter of said Section Number Six (5) in Township Number Ninety (90) North of Range Number Fourteen (14) West of the 5th P.M. be located Forty feet in width.

REPORT OF COMMISSIONER.

To the County Auditor of Black Hawk County:

The undersigned, appointed by you a Commissioner to examine into and report upon the expediency of establishing

a road described in the foregoing commission, respectfully reports:

That having been duly sworn, he found upon examination, that it was expedient and necessary for the accommodation of the public, that the road should be established, as shown by the plat of said establishment hereto attached and made a part of this report, therefore with the assistance of John Ball as surveyor, your Commissioner proceeded on the day set forth to wit: the 26 day of May 1892, to lay out and locate said road and to ~~deduct~~ set the same by the proper marks, ~~surrounds~~ around stakes, in the manner prescribed by law, and in accordance with the Field Notes and Plat of Survey of the Road, which are hereto annexed and which are made a part of this report.

Your Commissioner is of the opinion, that the establishment will be of benefit to the public, and would hereby recommend the establishment, forty (40) feet in width.

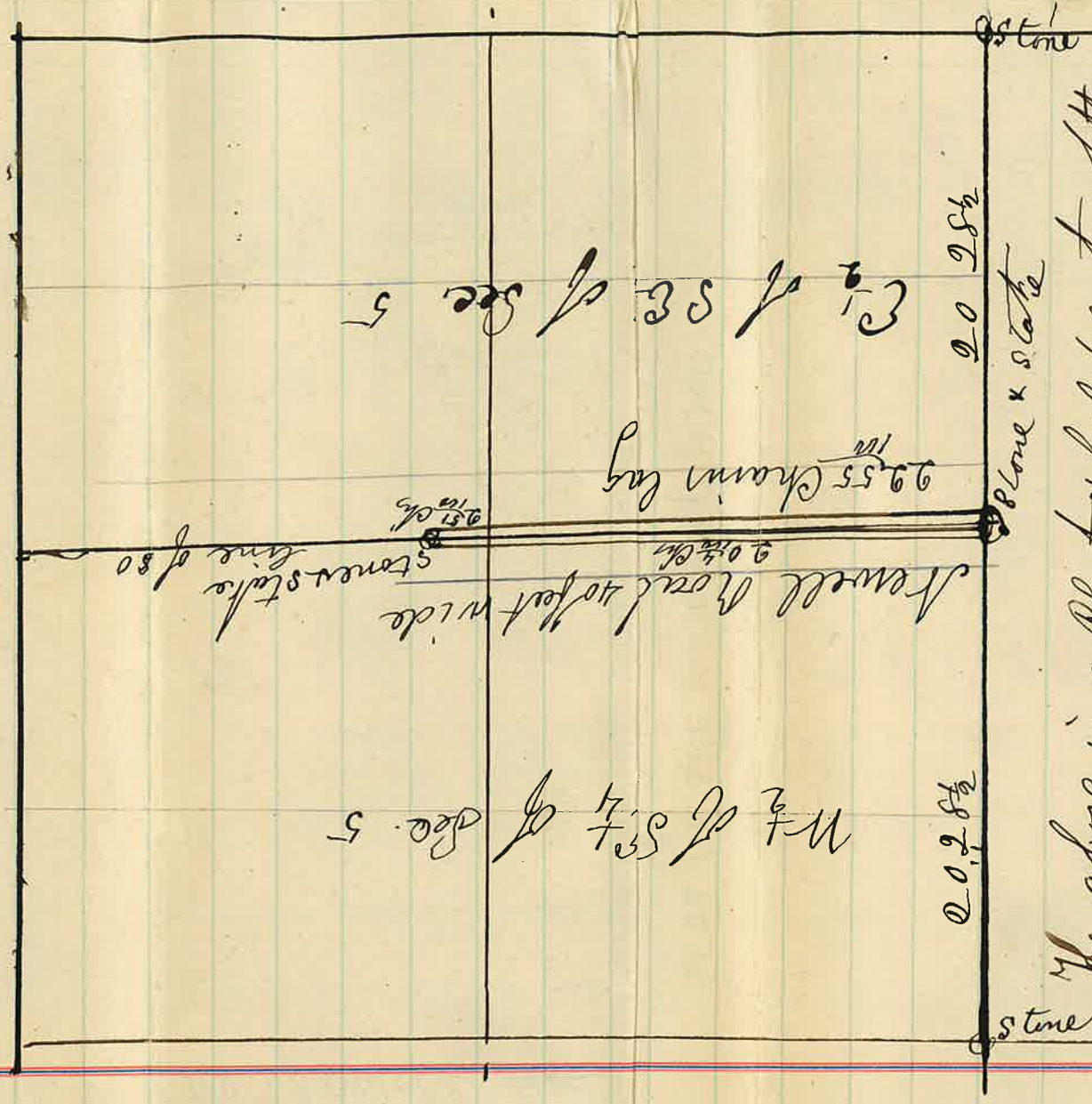

You will therefore appear at the office of some Justice of the Peace, Notary Public, or other proper officer, and qualify according to law, and on the 26 day of May A. D. 1892. you will proceed to make an examination of the route above described. If, in your judgment, the above road is needed, or one in the vicinity of the route described, answering the same purpose, you may call to your assistance the necessary aid, and, each being duly sworn, cause said line to be accurately surveyed and plainly marked out.

You will connect your starting point with the nearest section corner or quarter post. When, however, there is a corner of a forty established in a permanent manner, more convenient, you may connect with it. In crossing a section line, NOTE that fact, and state the distance from the nearest section corner or quarter post. The plat of the survey to accompany the field notes should be on the scale of forty chains to the inch, with the section crossed by the survey laid off upon the like scale, and correctly numbered as per United States survey. Also, note all natural or artificial monuments or conspicuous objects, and the junction of streams. Also, report the number of bridges required, if any, and the probable cost thereof, on the proposed highway, as required by Chapter 80, Laws Nineteenth General Assembly. A strict compliance with these requirements is necessary, in order to establish a uniformity in the practice, and to enable the Clerk to correctly transcribe them for record.

You will report your proceedings, together with a correct plat of the proposed road, to this office on or before the 16 day of June A. D. 1892.
