In consideration of the sum of Eighty Five (85) Dollars in hand paid by the County of Blackhawk in the state of Iowa, do hereby sell and quit claim to the said County of Blackhawk for the purpose of a public highway, the right of way over a strip of land Sixty six (66) feet wide, the center line of which, commencing at an iron pin set by M.L. Newton at a point on the south line of section Twenty five (25) township eighty-nine (89) north range Thirteen (13) west of the Fifth Principal Meridian in Blackhawk county, Iowa about Five Hundred and Three (503) feet west of the northeast corner of the north west quarter of the northeast quarter of section Thirty six (36) in township and range above written, where the middle line of Jefferson street, Hayes Addition to the city of Waterloo intersects the North line of said section Thirty six (36); thence southeasterly (about south 48° East on the prolongation of the middle line of said Jefferson street about Six Hundred and Eighty six (686) feet to its intersection with the middle line of the state road, at a point about Four Hundred and Sixty one (461) feet south of the northeast corner of the northwest quarter of the northeast quarter of said section Thirty six (36) which said point is marked by an iron pin set by the said M.L. REPORT OF COMMISSIONER.

To the County Auditor of Black Hawk County:

The undersigned, appointed by you a Commissioner to examine into and report upon the expediency of laying for public use

a road described in the foregoing commission, respectfully reports:

That on the 23rd day February 1893. I viewed the proposed site for a road and determined that the most feasible route for such road is along the extension of the center line of Jefferson St. until it should intersect the State Road in Sec 36 - 89-13, but owing to the state of the weather, the frozen ground and snow banks I postponed the survey of the Road till more favorable circumstances existed.

March 17th 1893 I made survey of the Road on the line as determined Feb. 23rd 1893, I found the soil along the line of a sandy loam and well adapted for roadmaking purposes. I think all necessary grading can be done on it without encountering any rock or hard clay.

Also, further reports that there will be no bridges needed on said proposed highway, and that the probable cost thereof will be _____ Dollars.

COMMISSION TO LOCATE ROAD.

(Form No. 65.)

To Auditor's Office, Black Hawk County, Iowa.

You are hereby notified, that you have been appointed a Commissioner to view, and, if required, to locate a County Road, petitioned for by J. M. Anixity and others, and described as follows, to-wit:

Commencing at a point near the intersection of Jefferson and 18th St. give a new addition to the City of Johnston, and running thence south easterly to the intersection of the Cedar Rapids and Cedar Falls State Road, set a point near the double corner by the Waterloo Paper Company, and occupied by J. J. Ellsworth.

~~and forwarding to~~

You will therefore appear at the office of some Justice of the Peace, Notary Public, or other proper officer, and qualify according to law, and on the 1st day of February A. D. 18 93 you will proceed to make an examination of the route above described. If, in your judgment, the above road is needed, or one in the vicinity of the route described, answering the same purpose, you may call to your assistance the necessary aid, and, each being duly sworn, cause said line to be accurately surveyed and plainly marked out.

You will connect your starting point with the nearest section corner or quarter post. When, however, there is a corner of a forty established in a permanent manner, more convenient, you may connect with it. In crossing a section line, NOTE that fact, and state the distance from the nearest section corner or quarter post. The plat of the survey to accompany the field notes should be on the scale of forty chains to the inch, with the section crossed by the survey laid off upon the like scale, and correctly numbered as per United States survey. Also, note all natural or artificial monuments or conspicuous objects, and the junction of streams. Also, report the number of bridges required, if any, and the probable cost thereof, on the proposed highway, as required by Chapter 80, Laws Nineteenth General Assembly. A strict compliance with these requirements is necessary, in order to establish a uniformity in the practice, and to enable the Clerk to correctly transcribe them for record.

FIELD NOTES.

The line a-b represents the center line of the road as located by my survey. The point c, being the $1/4 \times 1/4$ cor in the de. l. l. between the $SE 1/4$ of sec 25 and the $NE 1/4$ of $SE 26$.

a point on the section line between the S.E. 1/4 Sec 20 & the N.E. 1/4
of Sec 36 - 26 S. R. 13. W. 3 S. 18 E. Blackhawk Co. Ia. 49 ft
above the 1/4 - 1/4 corner between said quarter-sections, and thence
running south-easterly along the prolongation of the~~

The Road may be described by its center line, commencing at a point in the south line of Section 25, T³S. R. 13 W. S. 14 M. Blount County, Tenn. 503 1/2 feet west of the 1/4, 1/4 cor between the S. E. 1/4 of Sec. 25 and the N. E. 1/4 of Sec. 36, where the center line of Jefferson Struck of Hayes sold to the City of Martins intersects said south line of Sec. 25. Thence south easterly (about S. 48° E.) on the prolongation of said center line of Jefferson Struck 656 1/2 ft. to its intersection with the center line of the State Road at a point 461 ft. south of said 1/4, 1/4 corner on the section line between section 25 and 36.

from road 17 inches long were driven at the point
of intersection above named.
The width of the road is 66 feet, of which 40 feet
is to be on the south westerly side of said center line and 26 feet
on the north easterly side thereof.
