The undersigned respectfully petition that a Highway 20 feet wide, commencing at the south east corner of Lot No 3 in Section 35, Twp. 88, Range 12, W. of 5th P.M.

and running thence south along the West line, in said section 35 to the quarter section sec. 35, Twp. 88, Range 12, and section 2, Twp. 87 Range 12, being the point of termination of a road petitioned for July 11, 1893, and filed with the County Auditor October 3, 1893, by Felix Falk, et al., and terminating at
also continuing from this last point and running south along the East side of Lot 1, section 2, Twp. 87, Range 12, 50 Rods more or less, terminating at the South East corner of North 18⁵⁰/₁₀₀ acres of Lot 1, said section 2, be located

And we hereby represent that we are the owners in fee simple of all the lands affected by said proposed Highway, and hereby severally grant and give to the public the right of way over and upon our respective lands as above described, and waiving notice, relinquish all claims for damages by reason of such location.

Your County surveyor, being called to survey a proposed route for a public highway, respectfully reports that on the 5rd day of Nov 1893, he with the assistance of C. Miller, viewed and made a survey of the proposed line of road as follows:-

commencing at a point on the south line of section 36 Tp88 N. of R. 12 W. of the 5th P.M. Black Hawk County, Ia. 8.80 ch west of the S 1/4 cor stone of said 36 where the State Road intersects the south line of the said sec 36,

Thence west along the south line of sections 36 & 35, at 11.20 pass over stake and stone at 1/4 1/4 cor on south of the S.W. 1/4 of the said sec. 36;

at 31.22 ch pass over stone at the S.W. cor of sec 36 & S.E. cor of sec 35 from which Willow 48 in diam bears N.45 W 4 lks.

at 51.23 ch pass over 1/4 1/4 South of the S.E. 1/4 of sec 35, set a charred oak stake and stone in place.

at 61.22 pass over 1/4 1/4 cor,

set stake and stone in place.

at 71.21 ch to 1/4 cor south of sec 35-38-12 aforesaid, found old stake in place, set stone beside it, from which

W. Oak 18 in diam bears East 8 lks.

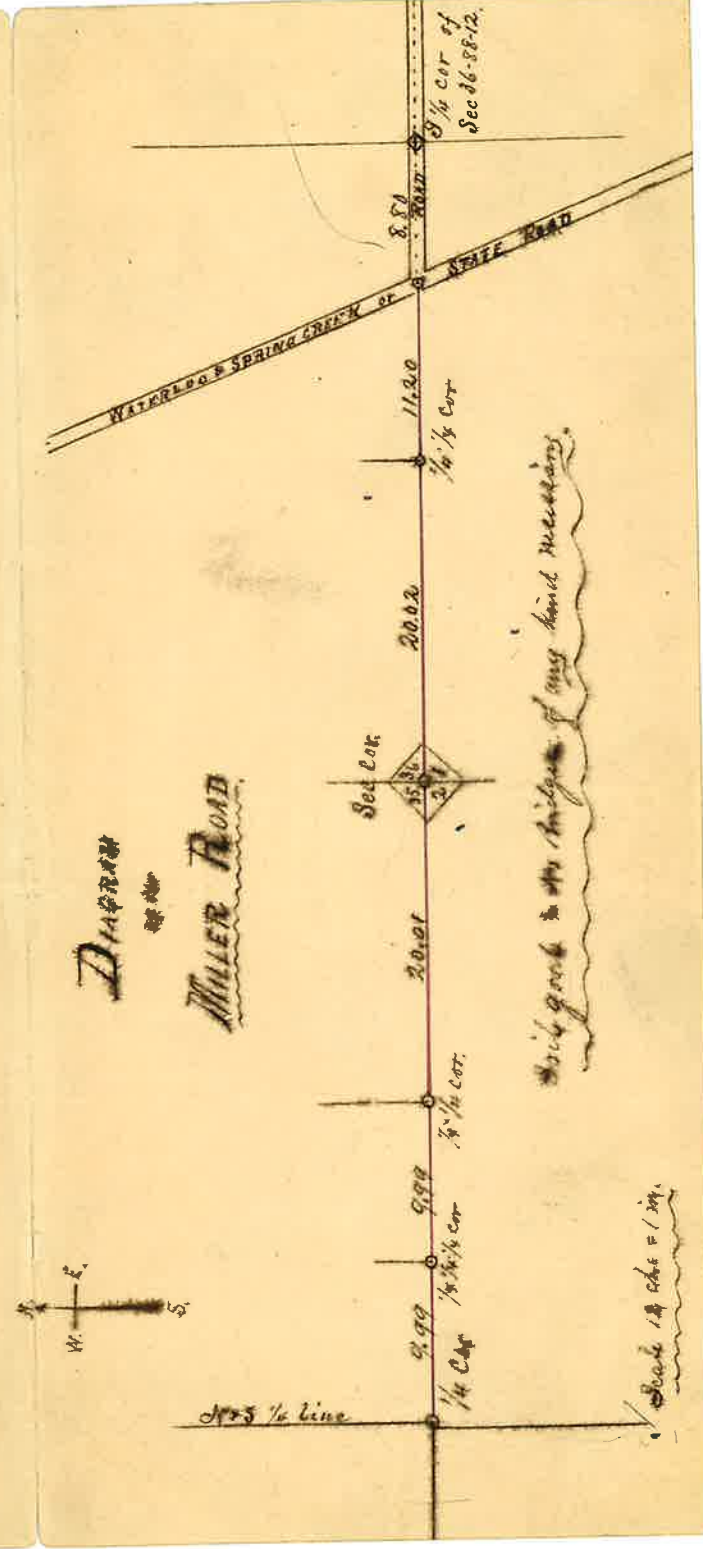
