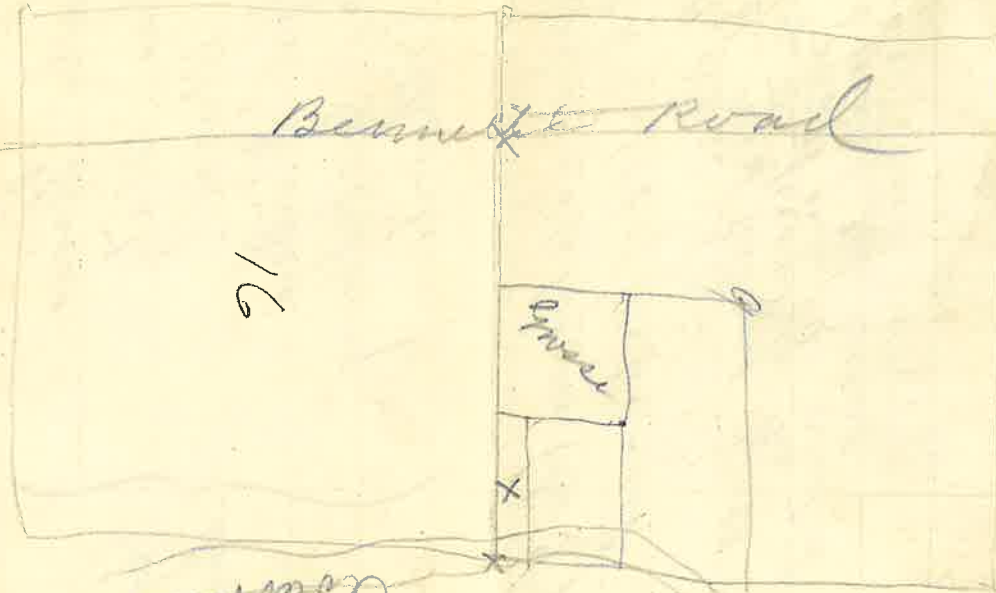

Your committee appointed at the last regular session of the board of Supervisors to view the road known as the Fish road in section No. One in Washington township to ascertain in regard to the need of an additional bridge to carry the surplus water after making what we considered a careful survey we considered the additional bridge not necessary. The cause for complaint seemed to be that there was not sufficient provision made for the egress of the water. we would recommend that the prayer of the petitioners be not granted. In regard to the road petitioned for by Charles Cross and others in between sections One & Sixteen in Union township would recommend that the prayer of the petitioners be granted. the county deriving the right and are hereby exempt from any expense whatever either in grading or bridging or for any other purpose.
