REPORT OF COMMISSIONER.

To the County Auditor of Black Hawk County:

The undersigned, appointed by you a Commissioner to examine into and report upon the expediency

of County Road between the Cities of Waterloo and Cedar Falls.

a road described in the foregoing commission, respectfully reports:

That after having carefully and thoroughly examined the route of the proposed road and finding that there are a number of people living along and adjacent to the line of said road having no means of outlet from their respective homes, and that the route surveyed and shown on the accompanying plat is needed by and for the use of said parties and others. — And further that there are no bridges required to be built at Co. expense, West of the East line of Sec. 22 of said plat and none required of greater span than eight (8) feet.

But as the petition and survey is for a bridge across the Blk. Hawk less than one half mile from the one already across said stream, and believing that travel between the two Cities will be amply served without incurring the added expense of another bridge with the expensive approaches required on the on the proposed line, I would suggest and recommend that the road be granted and established along the line surveyed from the East end of the Chandler Road to the point where the line of the proposed road intersects the N. & S. quarter line through Sec. 22, thence S. along said qr. line, intersecting the old Cedar Falls & Waterloo
