COMMISSION TO LOCATE ROAD.

You are hereby notified, that you have been appointed a Commissioner to view, and, if required, locate a County Road, petitioned for by W. A. Wright

and others, and described as follows, to-wit:

Commencing at a point 629 chains south of the
Quarter corner bet sections 10 and 15 - 30-14
and running thence south 71° 30' West 2.70 chains to the
NW 1/4 30-14
thence south 85° West 1 1/2 chains to the NW 1/4 30-14
thence south 70 rods west on line to the NW 1/4 30-14
to the north line of said section 15. thence
West to the North West corner of said section
thence 90. 00. 00. 14

and terminating at the last named point. said road
to be fifty (50) feet in width.

You will therefore appear at the office of some Justice of the Peace, Notary Public, or other proper officer, and qualify according to law, and on the 25th day of March A. D. 1896, you will proceed to make an examination of the route above described. If, in your judgment, it is necessary, or one in the vicinity of the route described, answering the same purpose, you may call to your assistance the necessary aid, and, each being duly sworn, cause said line to be accurately surveyed and plainly marked out.

You will connect your starting point with the nearest section corner or quarter post. When, however, there is a forty foot gap, and state the distance from the nearest section corner or quarter post. The plat of the survey to accompany the field notes should be on the scale of forty chains to the inch, with the section crossed by the survey laid off upon the plat scale, and correctly numbered as per United States survey. Also, note all natural or artificial monuments or conspicuous objects, and the junction of streams. Also, report the number of bridges required, if any, and the probable cost thereof on the proposed highway, as required by Chapter 80, Laws Nineteenth General Assembly. A strict compliance with the requirements is necessary, in order to establish a uniformity in the practice, and to enable the Clerk to correctly transcribe them for record.

You will report your proceedings, together with a correct plat of the proposed road

to this office on or before the 25th day of March A. D. 1896

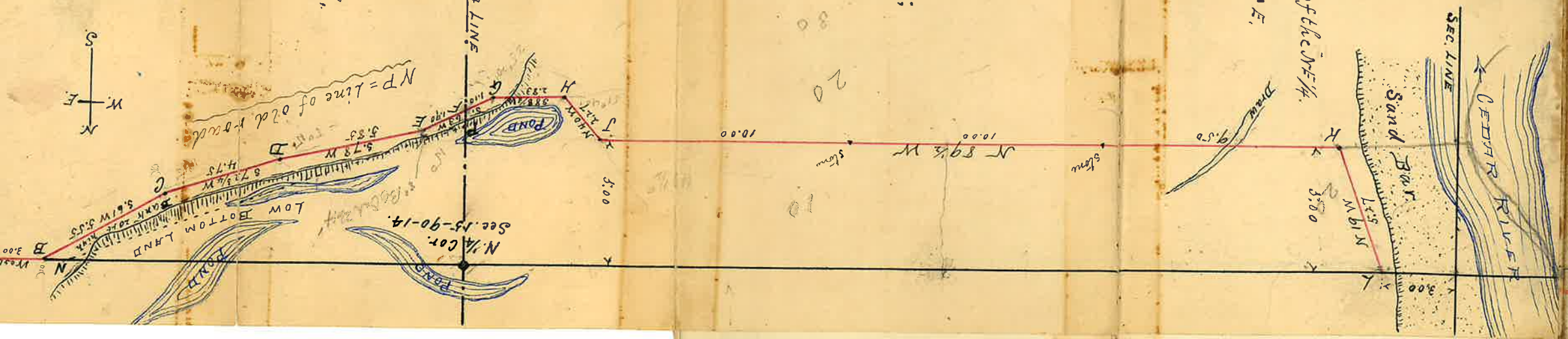

I, That said proposed highway is not
a public necessity when located as
indicated by said report, and further
that it is neither feasible nor prac-
ticable.

II, That such road when laid out a-
long the Section lying of Sections 10

I, that said proposed highway is not
a public necessity when located as
indicated by said report, and fur-
ther that it is neither feasible nor
practicable.

II, that such road when laid out
along the section line of section 10
and 15 in Washington Twp. from
at or near the north quarter corner of
said Sec. 15 to the river bank would
be much more feasible and prac-
icable as well as accessible to the
public.

III, that there is no saving in the
expense of construction of said
proposed highway over what it would
cost to construct same along the
proper section lines.

IV, that by the said proposed road

this party will be deprived of much more land than he would if said road was laid out on the section lying, and further he will be injured in his property by reason of the unlawful encroachment of said proposed highway going in a northerly direction across his land from the south line thereof, and he will be deprived of his present access to his river. That he will be damaged thereby in at least the sum of 50⁰⁰ dollars. V. That the commissioners report is not in conformity with the law in this, that he does not report the number of bridges to be constructed.

VI.

That said highway cannot be constructed without building of bridges, and the change in the course of same from a straight line is with an evident view of saving of certain bridges, and therefore the proper method has not been pursued under the law in this establishment of same.
