Dear Sir, I was notified on Nov. 10th, 1900 to file objections, or a claim for damages before Jan. 24th, 1901 on account of the location of a new road on the line described as follows, viz, Commencing at a point in the center of the Waterloo and Cedar Falls road where the Parker road intersects the same; said point being 1.44 chains north of the S. E. corner of the N. E. $\frac{1}{4}$ of the N. E. $\frac{1}{4}$ of Sec. No. 19 in Town No. 89. South of Range No. 13. West of 5th, P. M. thence running north in sections No. 19 and No. 18 in said Twp. and Range 54.99 chains, intersecting the Whiting road at a point 3.80 chains South of the N. W. corner of the S. E. quarter of said Section No. 18 Twp. 89, Range No. 13. Several years ago I tile drained the land along the south end of the proposed line of road with three inch tiles for more than half the distance that the new road would run on my ground. If the road should be located my claim for damages will be as follows:— That the 3 inch tile drain shall be extended in a workman like manner $3\frac{1}{2}$ ft. deep on the east side of the road to Mr. J. M. Rownds slough, (about 42 rods), and that my fence shall be set on the East side of the road in a workman like manner to the South-West corner of my barn yard without any cost to me. I will make no further claims for damages; but I will repeat again the extension of the tile drain and the rebuilding of my fence must be done in a workman like manner.

Dear Sir, I have been notified that a road commissioner was appointed by you, and that he has reported favorably on the location of a road as follows: to-wit: Commencing at a point in the center of the Waterloo and Cedar Falls road, where the Parker road intersects the same. Said point being 1,444 chains north of the center of the N. E. quarter of Section No. (19) nineteen in Town No. 89 north of Range No. 13 West of the 5th. P. M. Thence running north in sections No. (19) nineteen and (18) eighteen in said Township and Range 54, 99 chains intersecting the Whitney road at a point 3.80 chains south of the N. W. corner of the South-East quarter of said Section No. (18) Twp. 89. of Range 13. If the proposed road should be located my claim for damages will be forty-five dollars. You are hereby notified, that you have been appointed a Commissioner to view, and, if required to locate a County Road, petitioned for by the Board of Sch. Dist of Greenwood and others, and described as follows, to-wit:

Commencing at the Waterloo and Cedar Falls Road at the Northern terminus of the Barker Road and running thence (No 398) on the line between the

To the Board of Supervisors of Black Hawk County, Iowa.

The undersigned respectfully objects to the establishment of a highway in said County where the same passes along and on the East line of the North ~~East~~ West Quarter of the North East Quarter of Section Nineteen, through the South Half of the South East Quarter of Section No. Eighteen, and <sup>on</sup> the East line of the South Fifteen acres of the North West Quarter of the South East Quarter of said Section Eighteen, all of said land being in Township Eighty-nine Range No. Thirteen West of the 5th. P.M. in Black Hawk County, Iowa, and now owned by this complainant.

And these objections are made for the reasons that the said road is not a necessity, at the particular place where it is located.

2nd. That the same separates necessary pasture land of this complainant and cuts off the water from one half thereof, and necessitates the digging of another well at enormous expense, or the constant and continual driving of the ~~xxxxxxx~~ stock in said pasture to water.

3rd. That it will necessitate the erection and continual maintenance of Three fourths of a mile of fence.

4th. That it badly cuts up the lands of this complainant and very greatly reduces the value thereof.

5th. That its location is such that it crosses some very bad sloughs that will make continuous expense in keeping up, as well as very large expense in constructing.

This complainant further claims damage, if the said road is constructed as laid out, in the sum of Seven Hundred Dollars, as the reasonable and actual damage accruing against this complainant by reason of the establishment of the road as located.
