The undersigned respectfully petition that a Highway feet wide, commencing at a point twenty-three feet south of the north-east corner of section number twenty intownship number ninety north of range number fourteen west of the 5th P.M. and running thence west ^{thence north} ~~fifty~~ rods, thence south ten feet, thence east ^{thence north} ~~fifty~~ rods to the east line of said section number twenty and thence north ten feet to the place ~~and thence~~ of beginning (being a part of the "Hackett Road No. 57") be vacated.

Also that a road commencing at a point eighty rods west and one rod south of the north-east corner of section number twenty in township number ninety north of range number fourteen west of the 5th P.M. ~~and thence north~~ and running thence west twenty rods, thence south one rod, thence east twenty rods and thence north one rod to the place of beginning be laid out and established.
