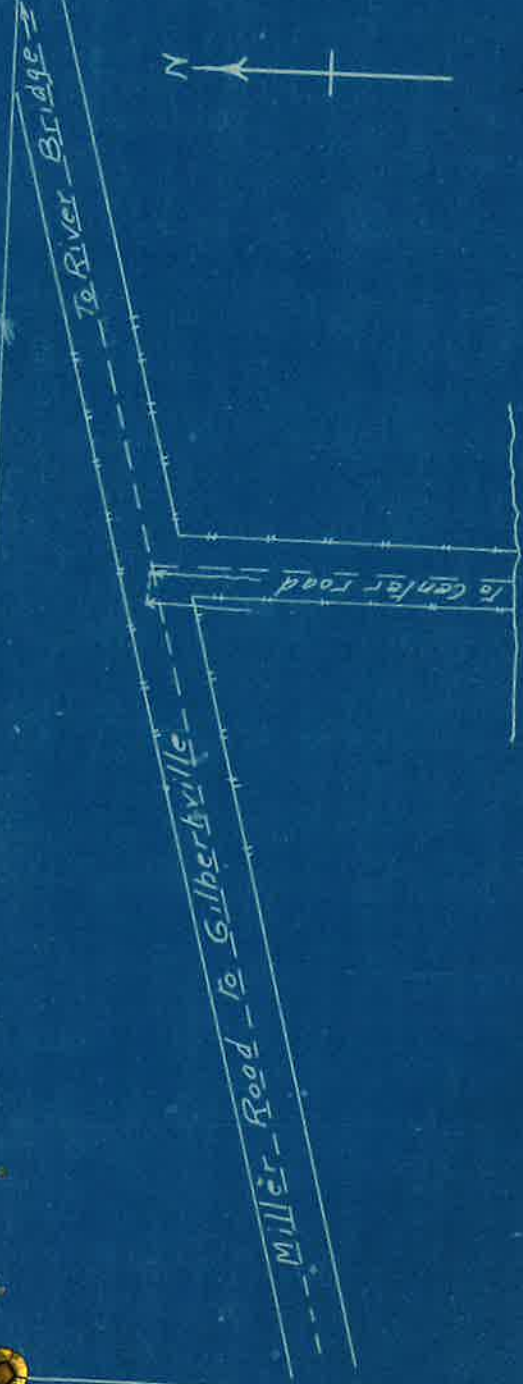

DESCRIPTION
For change in the YOUNGBLUT
(Chambaud St.) ROAD. in
SEC. 27 - 88 - 12.

Beginning at a point in the center of the Youngblut Road (Chambaud St.) as fenced and 1815.1' south of the center of the MILLER ROAD to GILBERTVILLE as now fenced; thence at an angle to the right of 10.19' 736.4' to the fence between the property of Victor Michel and Mrs. F. Youngblut; thence at an angle to the left of 34.19' 324.3' to the center of the present Youngblut (Chambaud St.) Road as fenced. Said change in the road to be 60' wide same as Chambaud St. and cuts off of V. Michel's land inside the fence 1.17 Acres.

To the Board of Supervisors of Black Hawk County:

The undersigned respectfully petition that a Highway 60 feet wide commencing at a point in the center of the Young-Bled Road (Chamberlain Street) as fenced and 1815' ft south of center of Milk road to Gilbertville as now fenced

and running thence at an angle to the right of $10^{\circ}19'$, 736.4' to the fence between the property of Leticia and Michaela and Mrs. Thompson; thence at an angle to the left of $34^{\circ}19'$, 374.3' to the center of the present ~~and terminating at~~ Young Bluff Chamberlain St. Road as fenced. Said change in the road to be 60' wide, same as Chamberlain St. and curbs of W. Nichols and inside the fence 11 acres be located and that the old road be vacated between their ~~bank~~

And we hereby represent that we are the owners in fee simple of all the lands affected by said proposed highway, and hereby severally grant and give to the public the right of way over and upon our respective lands as above described, and waiving notice, relinquish all claims for damages by reason of such location.
