To the Board of Supervisors of Black Hawk County:

The undersigned respectfully petition that a Highway _____ feet wide
commencing at _____

and a strip of ground one hundred feet (100) in width, the central line of which commences at the Southerly corner of lot number Two (2) block number twenty two (22) Hayes addition to the city of Waterloo, Iowa, extending thence Northeasterly to the Southwesterly bank of the Cedar river, thence in a Southeasterly direction along the Southerly bank of the Cedar river, the center line thereof being fifty (50) feet Southwesterly from the Southwesterly bank of the Cedar river. to a point where the North line of the South West Quarter (1/4) of the South West Quarter (1/4) of section number Thirty two (32) Township number Eighty Nine (89) Range twelve West of the 5 P.M. crosses the Cedar river being the point where Easton Avenue reaches the Cedar river. Also extending Easton Avenue from its present East terminus East to the river.

The recital herein of said Highway is that known & subject to this provision, to-wit:

That no street railway, electric railway or steam railway or railway of any kind shall be permitted, granted or chartered to give a right to use or occupy said strip for any purpose whatever we shall said strip a Highway to and by any of said kind of railway named for any purpose whatever except to cross said strip a Highway at a new right of way.
