The undersigned respectfully petition that a Highway 40 feet wide commencing at a point on the public highway near east end of bridge across Elk Run Creek near the north line of East Fractional half ($\frac{1}{2}$) of NE Fractional quarter ($\frac{1}{4}$) of Section Number five, (50, Township 88, Range 12.

and running thence southwesterly along the southeasterly bank of Elk Run Creek to point about one (1) rod north of the Northeast (NE) corner of land owned by Lore Alford Est. to connect with public highway running south along east line of said Alford Est land, aforesaid being road No. 578 as now recorded; thence south along, and ~~XXXXXXXXXX~~ and symmetrical with respect to, the west line of the East one half ($E\frac{1}{2}$) of the East One-half ($E\frac{1}{2}$) Section 5, Township 88, Range 12; also along the west line of the East One-half ($E\frac{1}{2}$) of East One-half ($E\frac{1}{2}$) Section Number 8, Township 88, Range 12, or be ~~located~~ until road reaches the Cedar River.

And we hereby represent that we are the owners in fee simple of all the lands affected by said proposed highway, and hereby severally grant and give to the public the right of way over and upon our respective lands as above described, and waiving notice, relinquish all claims for damages by reason of such location.

SURVEY AND FIELD NOTES OF HIGHWAY NO. 609

Highway No. 609 described by its center line, commences at the end of Highway No. 578 as recorded, which is about One (1) rod North of the Northeast (NE) corner of South west One-fourth ($SW\frac{1}{4}$) of the Northeast One-fourth ($NE\frac{1}{4}$) of Section Number 5, Township 88, Range 12 West; thence South along the West line of the East One-half ($E\frac{1}{2}$) of the East One-half ($E\frac{1}{2}$) Section Number 5, Township 88, Range 12, Four thousand fifty-one (4051') feet; also South along the West line of the East One-half ($E\frac{1}{2}$) of East One-half ($E\frac{1}{2}$) Section Number 8, Township 88, Range 12 West two thousand seven hundred forty-eight (2748') feet more or less until road reaches the Cedar River.

The above road is forty (40') feet wide as petitioned.
