You are hereby notified, that you have been appointed a Commissioner to view, and if required
to establish a proposed 50 ft. x a County Road, petitioned for by Fred Bolton

southeasterly (SELY) 178.6', thence South (S) 2106.9' to the Southwest (SW)

You will therefore appear at the office of some Justice of the Peace, Notary Public, or other proper officer and
qualify according to law, and on the 10th day of December A. D. 19 29
you will proceed to make an examination of the route above described. If, in your judgment, the above road is needed
or one in the vicinity of the route described, answering the same purpose, you may call to your assistance the necessary
aid, and each being duly sworn, cause said line to be accurately surveyed and plainly marked out.

You will connect your starting point with the nearest section corner or quarter post. When however, there is a corner of a forty estab-
lished in a permanent manner, more convenient, you may connect with it. In crossing a section line, note that fact, and state the distance
from the nearest section corner or quarter post. The plat of the survey to accompany the field notes should be on the scale of forty chains
to the inch, with the section crossed by the survey laid off upon the like scale, and correctly numbered as per United States survey. Also,
note all natural or artificial monuments or conspicuous objects, and the junction of streams. Also, report the number of bridges required,
if any, and the probable cost thereof, on the proposed highway, as required by section 4572 Code of 1924. A strict compliance with these
requirements is necessary.

You will report your proceedings, together with a correct plat of the proposed road
to this office on or before the 9th day of January A. D. 19 30.

The undersigned, appointed by you a Commissioner to examine into and report upon the expediency of

a road described in the foregoing commission, respectfully reports: **That I recommend the establishment of the proposed road herein described:**

Commencing at the Southeast (SE) corner of Southwest one-fourth (SW $\frac{1}{4}$) = NW $\frac{1}{4}$ Section 33-89-13, thence West (W) 528.8 feet, thence Southwesterly (SWly) along a 286.5 feet radius curve concave Southeasterly (SEly) 167.2 feet, thence West (W) 33° 26' South, 645.7 feet, thence Southwesterly (SWly) along a 191° radius curve concave Southeasterly (SEly) 191.7 feet, thence South (S) 2078.8 feet to the Southwest (SW) corner of Section 33-89-13. Said road to be 25 feet on each ^{side} of the above described center line.

Three (3) 24" pipe will be necessary to take care of the drainage. The approximate cost will be Two Hundred Twenty-five Dollars (\$225.00).

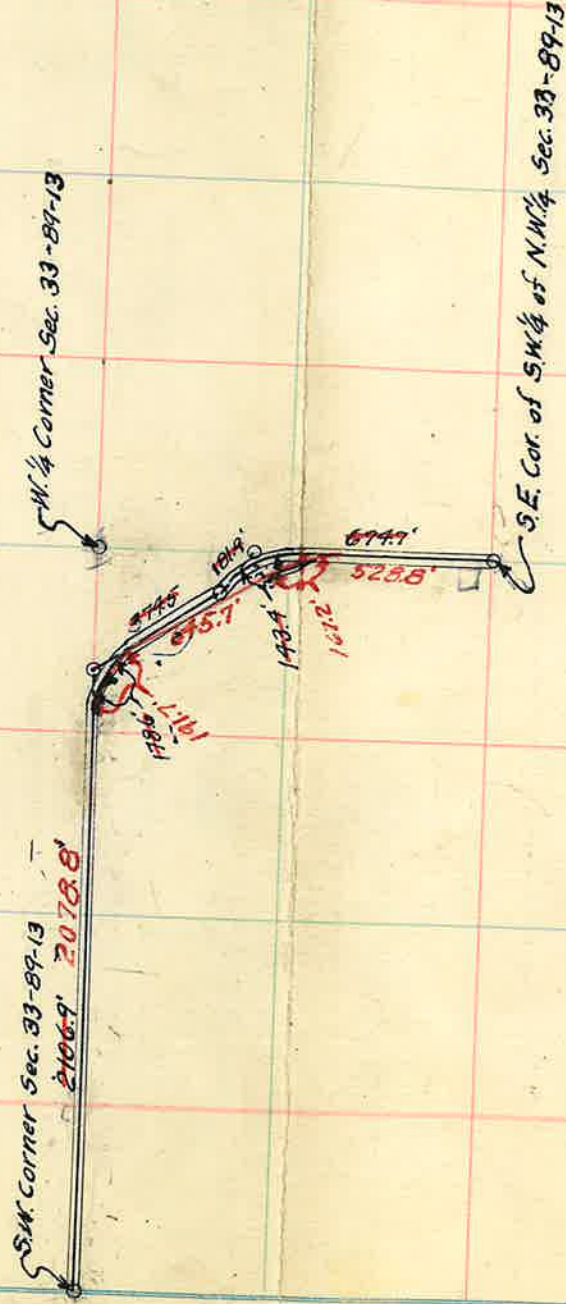

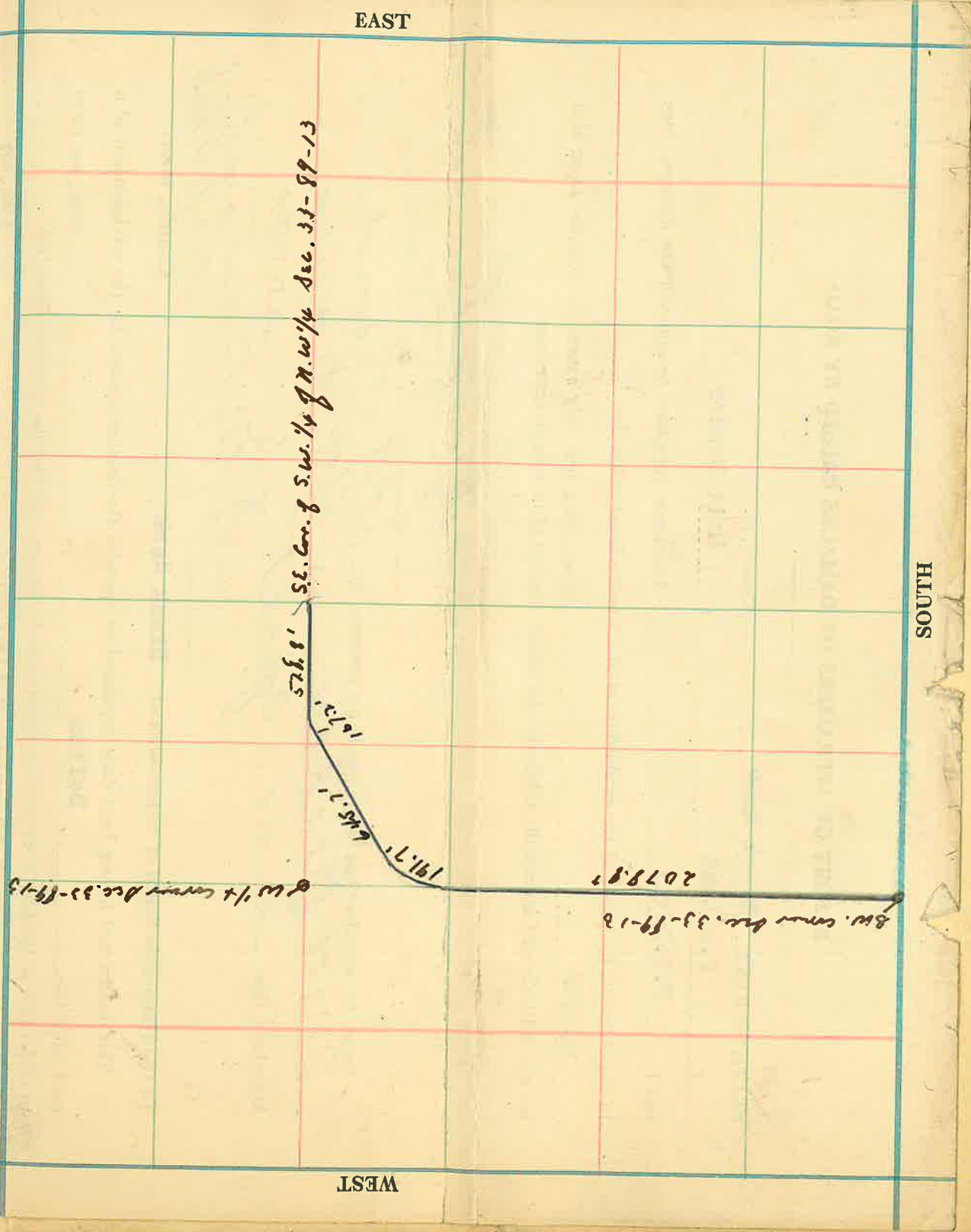
