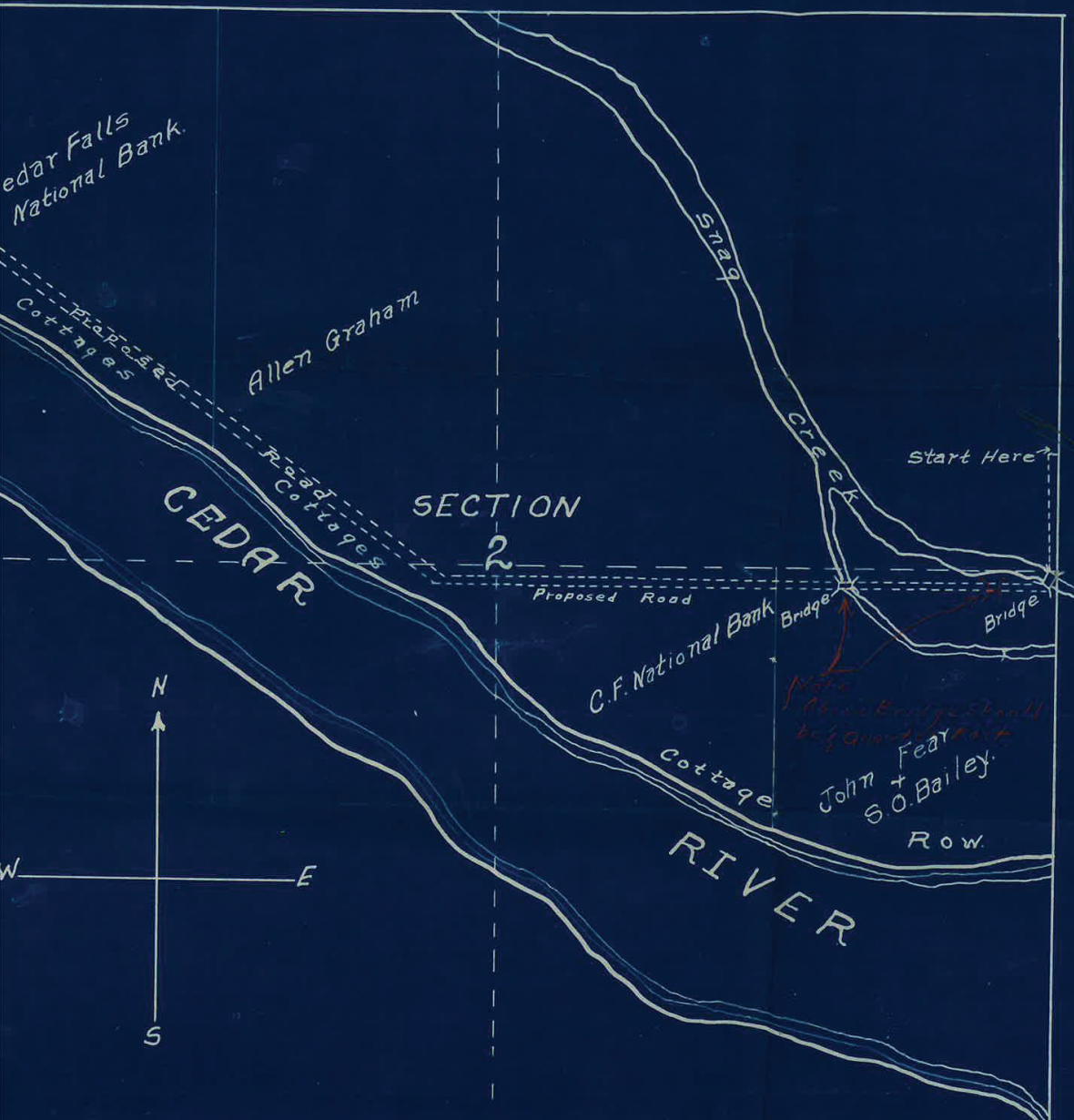

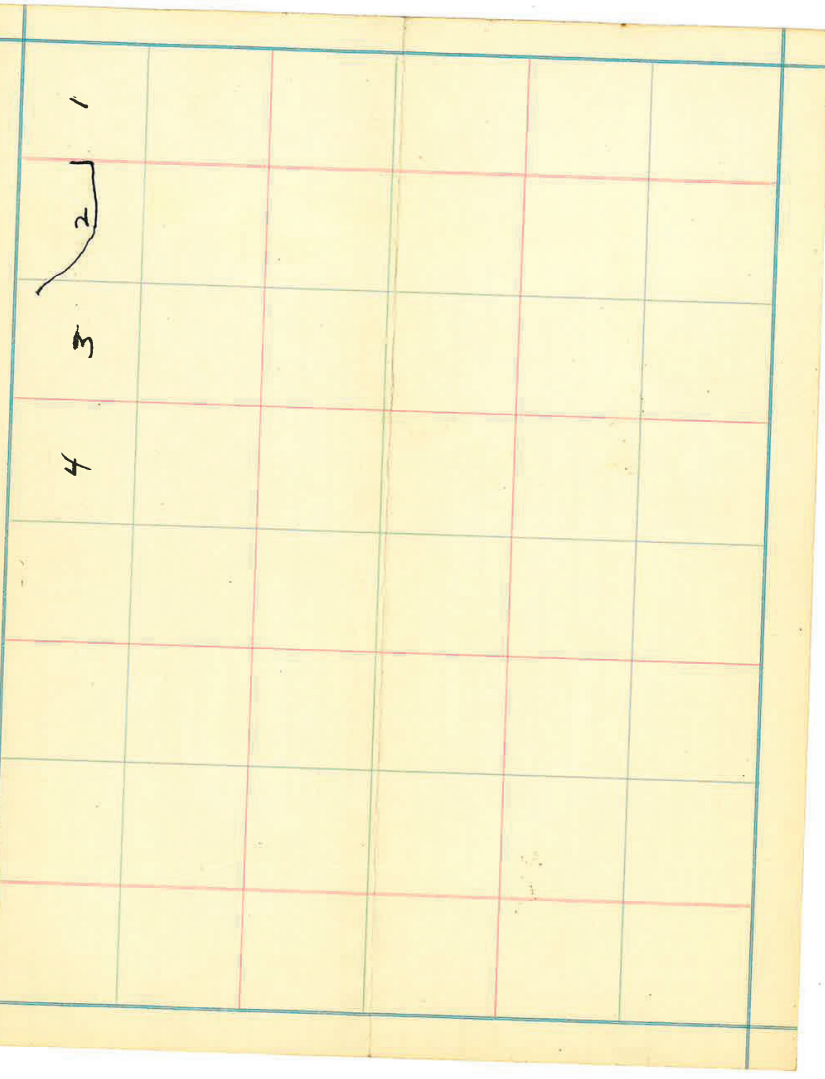

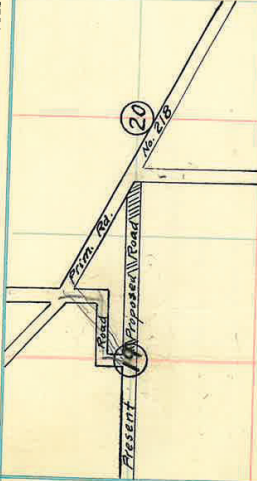

Dear Sir:

A few days ago you submitted to me the question of whether any further proceedings can be had after a commissioner, appointed under Section 4564 of the Code, has reported against the establishment of the highway.

Section 4567 provides in substance:

"In forming his judgment, the commissioner must take into account the public and private convenience, and the expense of the proposed road, and if he thinks the public convenience requires it, shall proceed at once to lay the same out, if the circumstances are such as to enable him to do so without having the same surveyed; but if, in his judgment, much road should not be established, he shall proceed no further, and in either case shall within thirty days after the day of his appointment, file his report in the auditor's office."

In Cook v. Trigg, 52 Iowa, 709, the Court held that following an adverse report by the commissioner, no further proceedings could be had by the Board of Supervisors or the Auditor, for the establishment of the road. It is true the law at that time read as follows:

"After a general examination, if he shall not be in favor of establishing the proposed highway, he will so report and no further proceedings shall be had thereon."

The change in the statute following the decision above referred to, has made the meaning of the present law rather doubtful. However, in view of Sections 4573, 4576 and of other sections in the same chapter, it is my opinion that the legislature did not intend to change the law. In other words, if the commissioner reports against the proposed establishment or alteration of the highway, no further proceedings can be had thereon.
