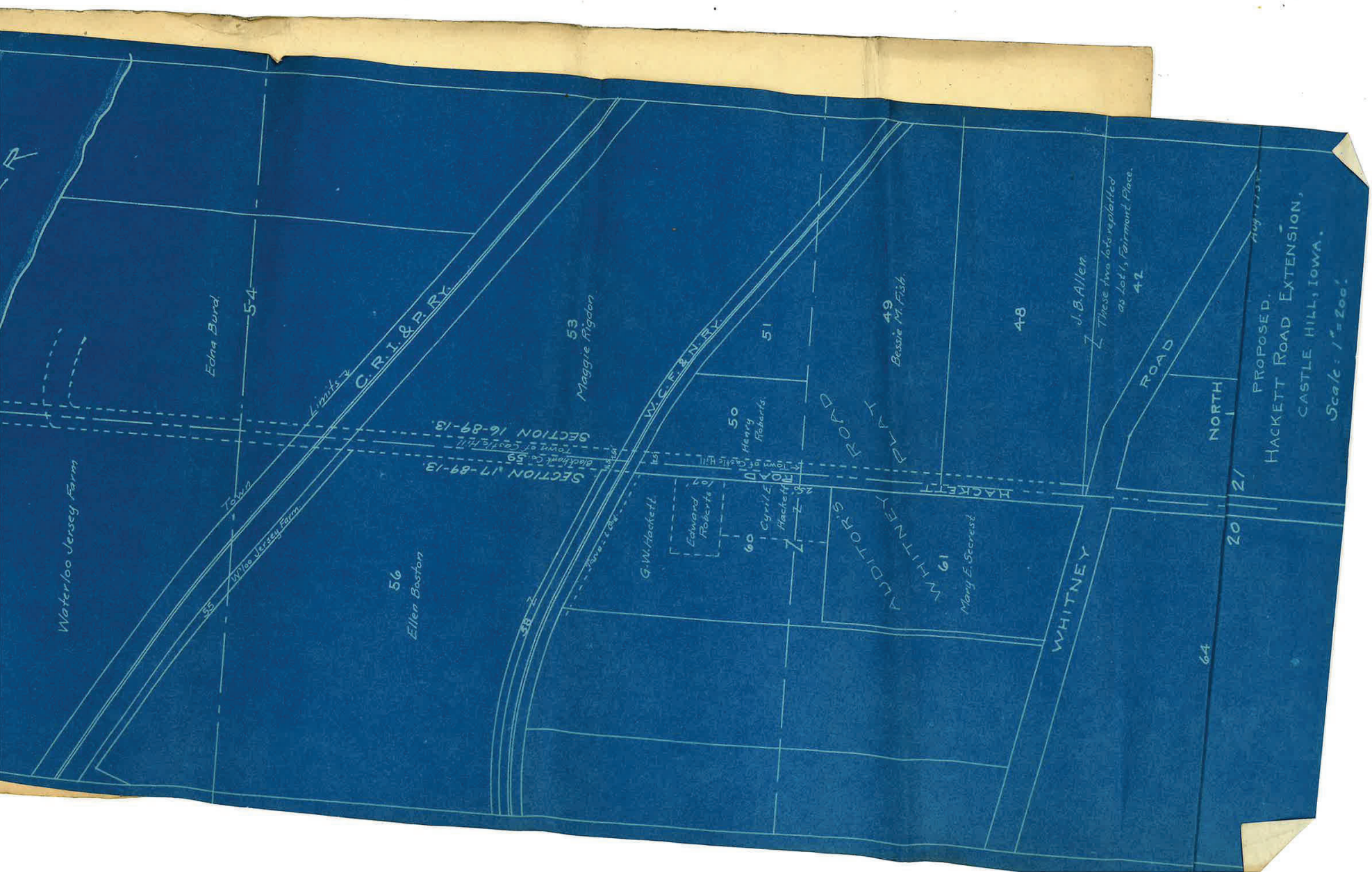

To the Board of Supervisors Black Hawk County, Iowa, we the undersigned residents and tax payers of Black Hawk County and of Cedar Falls Township Independent School District #1, do hereby petition the Board of Supervisors of Black Hawk County that they open a road for school purposes near the north line of Township 89, Section 1 Range 14, West of the 5th P.M., beginning at the East line of Woodlawn Addition and running eastward and intersecting what is known as the old Janesville Road.

Because of the development of Woodlawn Addition it has become necessary to provide School facilities for children in that vicinity. These children under present conditions would be compelled to travel more than 2 1/2 miles, which would necessitate transportation of them by the district; thereby raising the taxes to a prohibitive amount.
