Waterloo, Iowa, October 8, 1934.

The Board of Supervisors of the County of Black Hawk, in the State of Iowa, met in regular adjourned session at the Court House in Waterloo, County Seat of said County, at 9:00 o'clock A.M. pursuant to law, to the rules of said Board and to adjournment. The meeting was called to order by the Chairman, and on roll call there were present: Chairman, Geo. B. Miller; Matt Ahles, Walter H. Bell, John P. Biller, C. V. Kline, John R. Rector, Edw. Refshauge.

Mr. Refshauge presented the following resolution and moved its adoption, seconded by Mr. Rector.

WHEREAS, a petition has been presented to the Board of Supervisors, asking for the establishment of a public road to be known by the name of Sherwood Park Road as set forth in the following description:

Commencing at the intersection of Forester Avenue at Rainbow Drive as shown on the plat of Sherwood Park; thence North and Northwesterly on Forester Avenue to the intersection of Greenwood Avenue; thence in a Northwesterly direction on Greenwood Avenue to the West lot line of Lots 42 and 19 in Sherwood Park. The above being roads with widths as shown on the plat of Sherwood Park and Burds Sub-division of Sherwood Park. Thence continuing West with a 66' right of way approximately 500' to the West Section line of Section 16-89-13; thence South approximately 375' to the Northeasterly right of way line of the C. R. I. & P. R. R. The above being approximately 1.25 miles in length.

said road to be taken over and made a part of the Secondary Road System of Black Hawk County, and

WHEREAS, the petitioners are the owners of all the land embraced within the said above description and each and all of the owners of said land have agreed to severally grant and give to the public the right-of-way over and upon their respective lands as above described, and waiving notice, relinquish all claims for damages by reason of such location, and

WHEREAS, the said Board of Supervisors, after due investigation and consideration have decided that the highway as herein described is a public necessity and convenience,

NOW, THEREFORE, Be It Resolved by the said Board of Supervisors that the above described road should be, and is hereby established this 8th day of October, 1934.
