Waterloo, Iowa, September 16, 1940.

The Board of Supervisors of the County of Black Hawk, in the State of Iowa, met in regular adjourned meeting at the Court House in Waterloo, County seat of said County, at nine o'clock (9:00) pursuant to law, to the rules of said Board, and to adjournment. The meeting was called to order and on roll call there were present: Chairman, Geo. B. Miller, Frank W. Beck, Walter H. Bell, John P. Biller, C. V. Kline, Edw. Refshauge, and Val Schmit.

Absent: None.

Mr. Beck moved the adoption of the following resolution, seconded by Mr. Refshauge:

WHEREAS, the following described roads have heretofore been dedicated to the public for road purposes:

That part of the West sixty-six (66) feet of the East one-half of Section 32, Township 89 North, Range 12, West, between Highway #297 and Morrell Avenue, if extended; also all Morrell Avenue West of Grand Blvd. and also a strip forty (40) feet wide running from the West end of Morrell Avenue to the West line of the Southeast Quarter of Section 32, Township 89 North, Range 12 West, same being a continuation of Morrell Avenue.

IT IS THEREFORE RESOLVED by the Board of Supervisors of Black Hawk County, Iowa, that the above described road be taken into and made a part of the Secondary Road System of Black Hawk County.
