Establishment of a Road in the
Secondary Road System.

Waterloo, Iowa, April 23, 1951

The Board of Supervisors of the County of Black Hawk, in the State of Iowa, met in regular adjourned meeting at the Court House in Waterloo, County Seat of said County, at nine o'clock (9:00) a.m., pursuant to law, to the rules of said Board, and to adjournment. The meeting was called to order and on roll call there were present: Chairman, Edw. Refshaug, Carl R. Davis, David E. Keith, C. V. Kline, Francis Messerly, Earle A. Munger and Val Schmit.

Absent: None.

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Moved by Kline seconded by Munger that when the owners of all the lands affected by a proposed highway sixty-six (66) feet wide, commencing at the Southeast (SE) corner of Section Seven (7), Township Eighty-eight (88), Range Twelve (12) thence running one-half mile North between Section Seven (7) and Eight (8), severally grant and give to the public the right of way as above described, the Board of Supervisors establish said road as part of the Secondary Road System.

Nays: Keith and Schmit. Motion carried.
