BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED by the Board of Supervisors of Black Hawk County, that the following Streets, all in Mayfair Third Addition, Washburn, be and are hereby taken into the Secondary Road System:

4th Street from the South edge of Lot 300 to Maple Street.
Maple Street from the East edge of Lot 342, thence East.
Elm Street from Pine Street to 4th Street.
Pine Street from 4th Street to Maple Street.
