heretofore had in relation to the Establishing
a Public Highway in said County called
The "Cedar Valley & Black Hawk Creek Road"
that there was an error in the transactions
connected therewith, in this, that no
notice of the Application in that case was
Posted in Black Hawk Township accor-
-ding to Law. This Affiant further
says that he posted the notices for said
Road & that he had then no knowledge
that said road would run into said
Black Hawk Township when the affidavit
of Posting notices therein was made
Subscribed & sworn before James Munger
on this 7th day of February A.D. 1837

Now to wit February 7th A.D. 1837.

1837 Came James Munger a citizen of Black Hawk County
& moved the Court to set aside so much of an order her-
etofore made establishing the Cedar Valley & Black
Hawk Creek road as did establish said road or a portion
thereof in Black Hawk Township in said County for
reasons set forth in the foregoing affidavit of said

James Munger on file in this Court which said
Motion is granted by the Court; & that part of
said road running into said Black Hawk
Township is hereby declared set aside & made
null & void

Road Bond.

KNOW ALL MEN, by these Presents, That we, James Munger
and the Undersigned Citizens
of the county of Black Hawk, and State of Iowa, are held and firmly bound unto the county
of Black Hawk in the sum of fifty Dollars
for the payment of which, well and truly to be made, we bind ourselves, our heirs, executors, ad
ministrators, and every of them, firmly, by these presents.

The Condition of the above Obligation is such, That, whereas said
Munger and others has this day made application, by petition, to the
County Court of said county, to appoint a commissioner to view and locate a county road, called
Leeder Valley & Black Hawk Creek Road

Now, if the said road shall be established according to law, and the same become a public
highway, in accordance with the statute in such cases made and provided, then this obligation to be
void: otherwise, to be and remain in full force and virtue.

To Hon^{ble} Probate Judge of Black Hawk County Iowa

Sir

Agreeable to Commission
and according to instructions I proceeded to view and lay out
a Road (Call the Cedar Valley and Black Hawk Creek
Road) Commencing one half mile East of the Section Corners between
Nineteen Twenty (Twenty nine & Thirty) at the Quarter post erected
by Government Surveyors which post appears to stand in the center of
State Road thence west between said Sections to Township Eight
Eight (88) Range Fourteen (14) West where it enters the Black
Hawk Creek Road One fourth of a mile West of Section Corners of
Twenty three Twenty four Twenty five & six Crossing the Township
lines of Cedar Orange & Black Hawk also across the Starr Settlement
Road Cedar Falls & Big Creek Road also across a small stream
Calla Prescotts Creek Said proposed Road passes over high
dry & rolling Prairie most of the way. I believe the Road will
be beneficial to the Settlement & would recommend its establishment
