Know all Men by these Presents, THAT WE, Jeremiah Gay

of the County of

Black Hawk and State of Iowa, are held and firmly bound unto the County of Black Hawk
in the sum of Fifty Dollars for the payment of which, well and
truly to be made, we bind ourselves, our heirs, executors, administrators, and every of them, firmly by these presents.

THE CONDITION OF THE ABOVE OBLIGATION IS SUCH, That, whereas, Jeremiah Gay
Levi Monson and others has this day made application by petition, to the
County Court of said County, to appoint a commissioner to view and locate a road, called the Gay Road
in Township 88 & 87 Range 12 West

NOW, If the said road shall be established according to law, and the same becomes a public highway, in accordance with the statute
in such cases made and provided, then this obligation to be void: otherwise, to be and remain in full force and virtue.

WITNESS our hands, this Seventh day of September A. D. 1857.

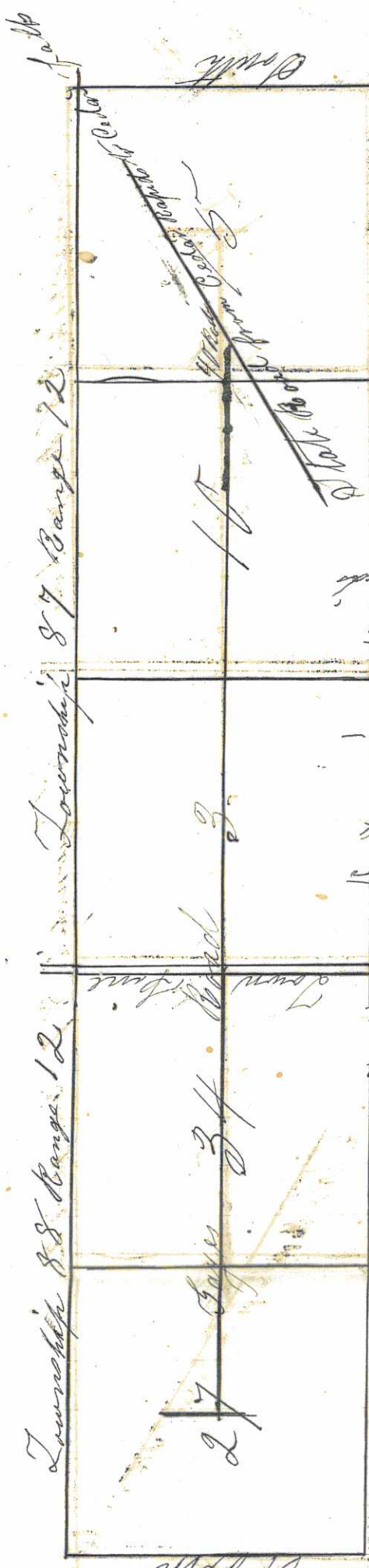
