After due consideration of the protests entered by those appearing it was then moved by Kline seconded by Messerly that only the following described roads be and the same are hereby vacated, and that the County Auditor be authorized and directed to correct his records accordingly:

1. County Road No. 76 running along the North Side of the West Half ($W\frac{1}{2}$) of the Southeast Quarter ($SE\frac{1}{4}$) of Section 24-87-11; the North Side of the Southwest Quarter ($SW\frac{1}{4}$) of Section 24 Township 87 Range 11; and the West Side of the North Half ($N\frac{1}{2}$) of the Northwest Quarter ($NW\frac{1}{4}$) of the Southwest Quarter ($SW\frac{1}{4}$) of Section 24 Township 87 Range 11.
2. County Road No. 191 running East and West between Sections 24 and 25 in Township 89 Range 11.
3. County Road No. 548 running North and South between Sections 35 and 36 in Township 89 Range 11.
4. The East three-fourth ($E\frac{3}{4}$) of a mile of County Road No. 438 running East and West between Sections 4 and 9 in Township 89 Range 12.
5. That part of County Road No. 143 running through Sections 13 and 14 Township 90 Range 11.

KNOW ALL MEN, by these Presents, That we, Angus Mc
Wright Henry Gipe David Harmon
of the county of Blackhawk, and State of Iowa, are held and firmly bound unto the county
of Blackhawk in the sum of Fifty Dollars
for the payment of which, well and truly to be made, we bind ourselves, our heirs, executors, ad
ministrators, and every of them, firmly, by these presents.

The Condition of the above Obligation is such, That, whereas Angus
McWright has this day made application, by petition, to the
County Court of said county, to appoint a commissioner to view and locate a county road, called
the Spring Creek & Prairie Point
Road.
Now, if the said road shall be established according to law, and the same become a public
highway, in accordance with the statute in such cases made and provided, then this obligation to be
void: otherwise, to be and remain in full force and virtue.
