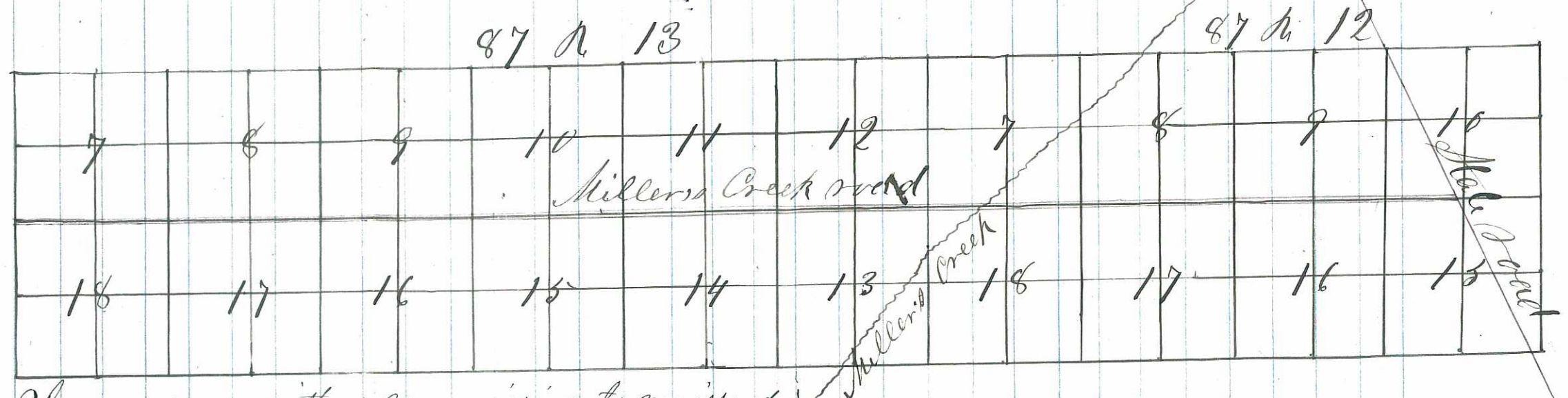

In accordance with a commission to me issued from the County Court of Black River County, Wisconsin the 27 day of February 1858 to view a route for a road Petitioned for by Elisha Starbuck & others commencing at the State road between sections 10 & 15 in Township 87 Range 12 west in said County I did on the said day view said route, found the same good and no inconvenience in making a road on the same except a bridge about 12 feet wide which it will be necessary to build across Miller's Creek. I further Report that I found great necessity existing for a road upon said route and think the same should be established.

A Plat of said route fees viewing one day \$1.50
 is hereto annexed & " Preparing & Making Return 1 day 1.50

The above is a correct plat of Miller's Creek road. Length about 9 1/2 miles. The route is practicable and would recommend the establishment of said road.
