

Road - The location of which said road has been

said road is very crooked circuitous and inconvenient
to travel - That no portion of the inhabitants
as either here or elsewhere will be benefited by it
That it is not only useless - but an injury to those
through whose lands it is located - Therefore
we the undersigned would respectfully remonstrate
against the location of said road or
any part thereof
