M., and running West on the line between the Counties of Butler and Grundy to the West line of said Counties; and the right of way having been granted by written agreement as the law requires it is ordered by the Court that the above petition be granted and the road be established so far as this Court has jurisdiction of the same, to be marked out by, and at the expense of the petitioners.
