There will be a Petition for the establishment of a Public Highway to be called the Owens Road upon the following route to wit Commencing at the South East corner of Section Five in Township Sixty North, Range Eleven in the County of Black Hawk State of Iowa running thence west on the section line about eight miles until it would intersect the road leading from Independence in Buchanan Co to Bradford in Chickasaw County presented to the County Court of said Black Hawk County at the February Term of said Court AD 1858

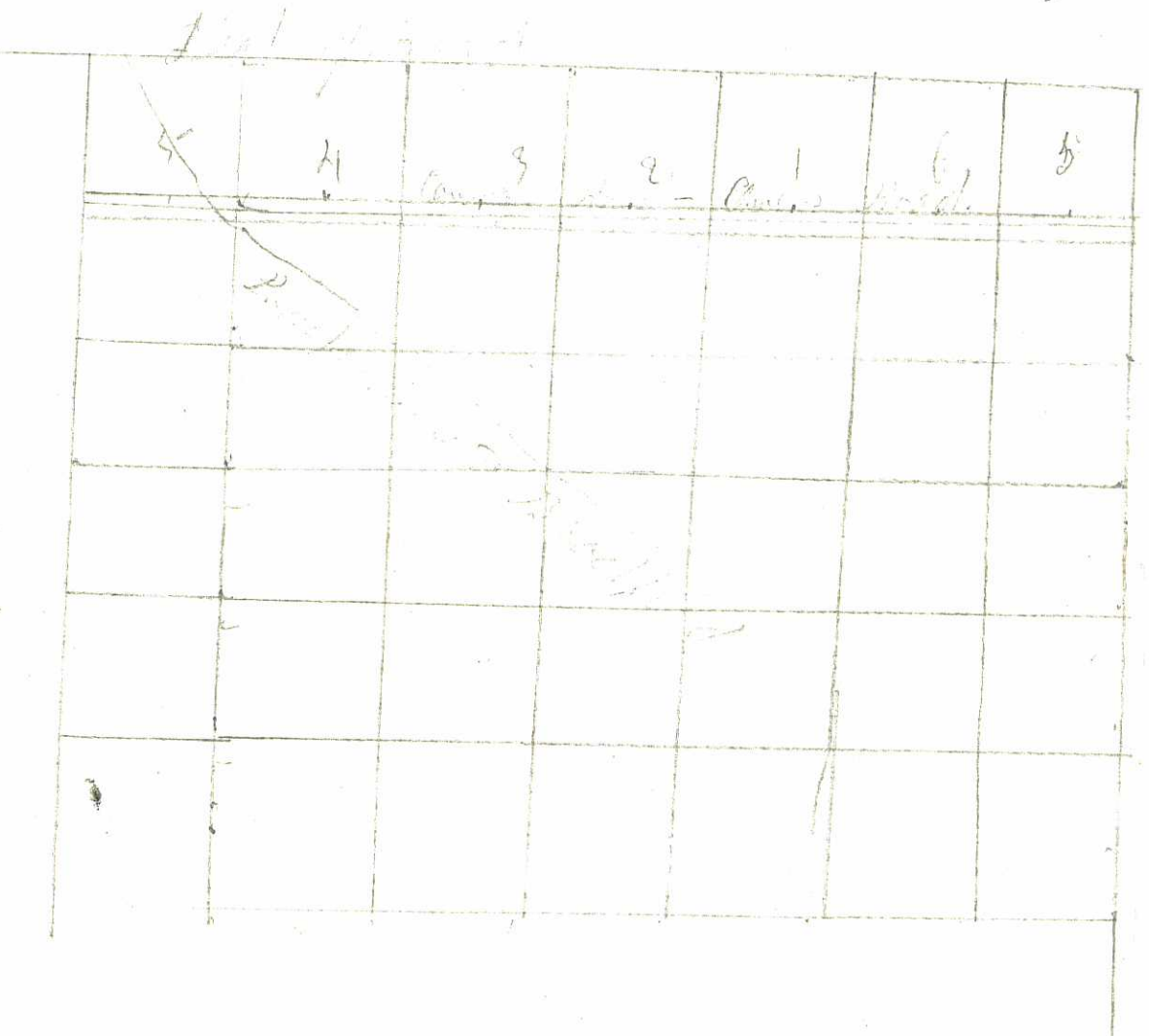
Commissioner's Report-
