

To the Honorable County Court, of Black Hawk County, Iowa. The undersigned inhabitants of said county, respectfully showeth, that we desire a change of road in the State road leading from Cedar Falls, in Black Hawk County to Forest City in Winneshiek County. The desired change will commence eighty rods east of the south west corner of section sixteen (16) where said State road intersects the south line of said section sixteen (16) in Township no. Ninety North of Range fourteen west of the fifth Principal Meridian in Iowa. From thence west one hundred & sixty rods. thence north one hundred & sixty rods. or to the half mile line east & west in section seventeen, thence west one mile & one fourth. Reaching the center post in section eighteen thence north one mile or until it crosses the West fork of the Red Cedar river.

(All of the above described road is an established & traveled road known as the "Hackett & Kettner's road." And from the north bank of said west fork, to run in a westerly direction as near as practicable for road purposes to said west fork over one half mile reaching to the west line of Black County and from thence north one mile, (which is an fine & established road in Butler County Iowa.) Where the desired road will again intersect the line of said State road. And we the undersigned request that a commissioner may be appointed to run said road, and that all other acts necessary to effect the desired change may be done.
