State for the State of Iowa

We the un-
designated commissioners appointed by an
act of the 6th General of the State of
Iowa (see Chap 192 page 308) to locate and
establish a state Road from Cedar Falls
in Black Hawk Co by way of steam road,
near in Hardin Co to Fort Des Moines in
Polk County. Beg leave to report that on
the 18th of October A.D. 1838 taking to
our assistance a Surveyor and the
necessary hands all duly sworn by us
after subscribing the oath hereto attached
we then proceeded to locate and establish
the said road in accordance with the
requirements of the law - in such cases
provided as is more fully shown by
the surveyors plans and filed notes of the
survey hereto appended and made part
of this report

We do also certify that the
following named persons were employed on
the survey and are entitled to the
several sums set opposite their respect-
ive names

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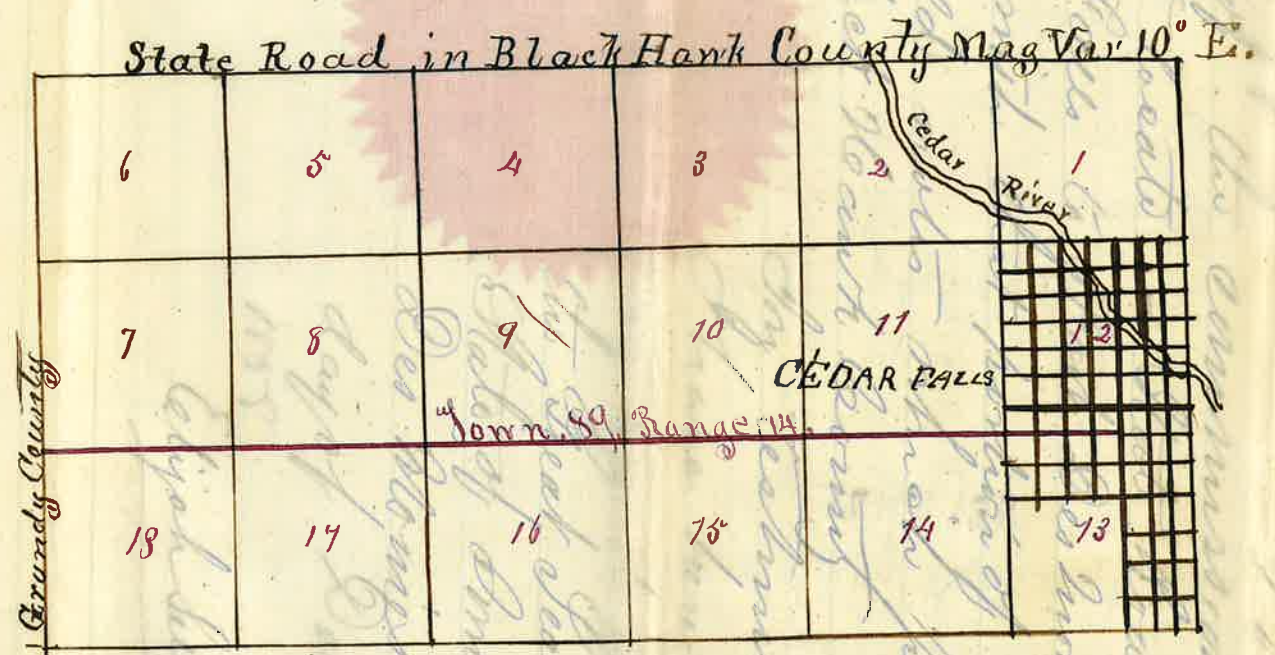
