Morton et al has this day made application by petition, to the
County Court of said County, to appoint a commissioner to view and locate a road, called The Barclay +
Garrison Road.

NOW, If the said road shall be established according to law, and the same becomes a public highway, in accordance with the statute
in such cases made and provided, then this obligation to be void: otherwise, to be and remain in full force and virtue.
