THE CONDITION OF THE ABOVE OBLIGATION IS SUCH, That, whereas, Said William L. Norton et al has this day made application by petition, to the County Court of said County, to appoint a commissioner to view and locate a road, called The Barclay & Jamesville Road

NOW, If the said road shall be established according to law, and the same becomes a public highway, in accordance with the statute in such cases made and provided, then this obligation to be void: otherwise, to be and remain in full force and virtue.
