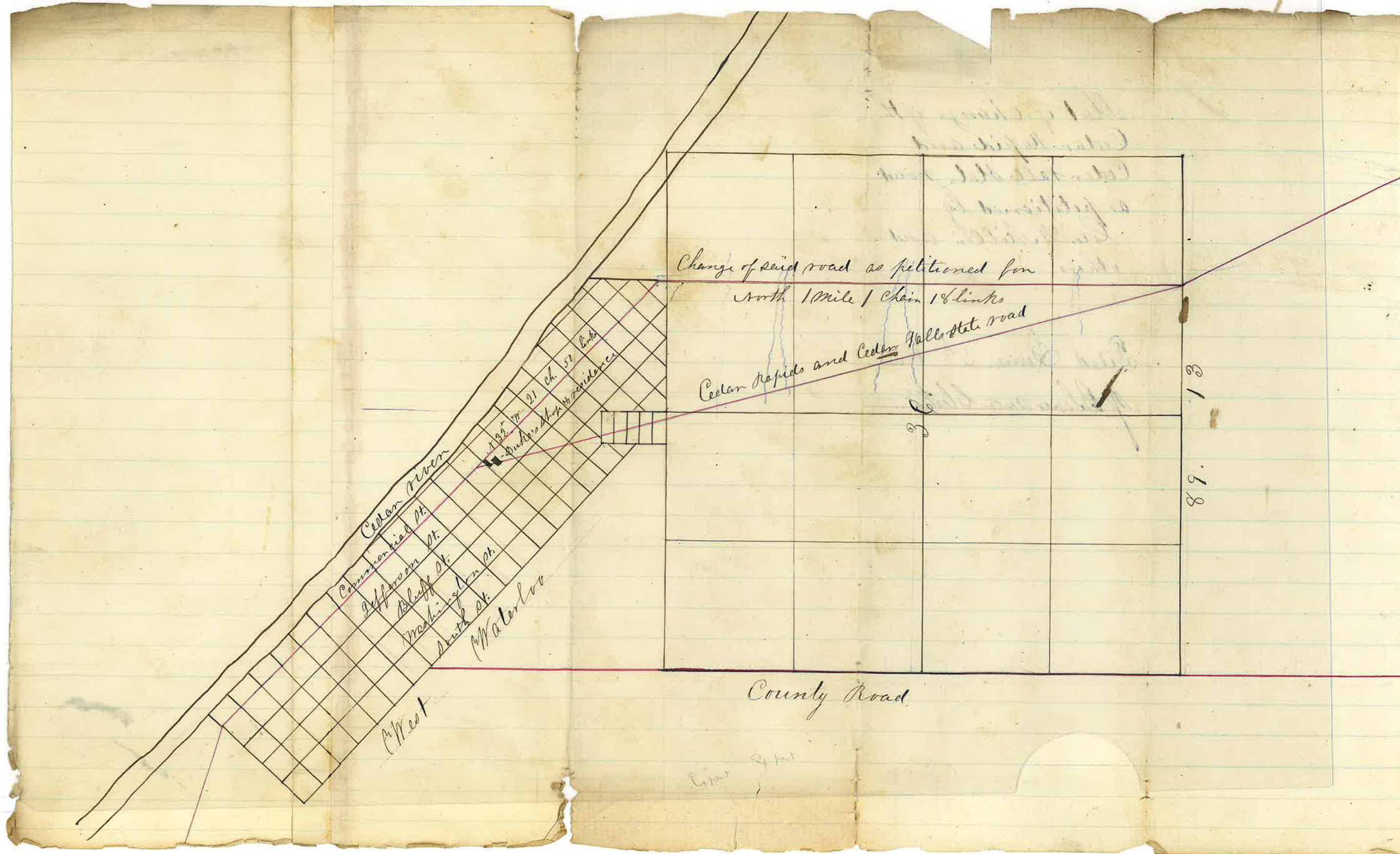

The above is a correct plat of the Cedar Rapids and Cedar Falls state road as it is located immediately south east of the village of Waterloo Black Hawk County Iowa and across the south eastern portion of the village plat of Waterloo, together with the change as petitioned for by Geo. W. Hillen and others. I have carefully and impartially examined into the propriety of said change and find that the route upon which it is asked to be changed is far preferable to the one upon which it is now located. Said road now runs over much more wet and sloughy land than it would were it changed as petitioned for. It is also highly injurious to the property holders as it now runs diagonally over some valuable land adjacent to the village plat, as well as across some valuable out-lots, village-lots streets and alleys in said village of Waterloo. It also runs through Patrick Dubois Black Smith shop and residence in Waterloo which are permanently built of stone and must be removed in case said road remains as it is now located, and opened as a public high-way. From the above considerations I would recommend that said change be made as it is petitioned for and permanently established as a public high-way - and that that portion of the Cedar Rapids and Cedar Falls state road which is between Commercial street in the village of Waterloo and the south line of section no. thirty six (36) in Township no. Eighty nine (89) north of range no. thirteen (13) west be discontinued.

We the undersigned
Citizens of said Co. humbly petition
your Honor to appoint some suitable
person or Commission to examine
into the propriety of changing the Cedar
Rapids and Cedar Falls State road
immediately South East of the village
of Waterloo in said County. Said change
is to Commence at some suitable point
in said road in Section No. Thirty Six
(36) in Township No. Eighty Nine (89)
North of Range No. Thirteen (13) West,
and thence to run on a straight line
either to Jefferson or Commercial Street
in Waterloo, as said Commission may
think best. Said road as it is now located
is highly injurious to the property holders as
it runs diagonally across village and
out-lots, and property intersect, no street.
Its present location is also inconvenient
to the travelling Community. We therefore
humbly petition your Honor that this our
request may be granted.
