You are hereby notified that you have been appointed a Commissioner to view, and if required to change a County Road petitioned for by William Mobley and others said change as follows to wit, an alteration in that part of the County Road commanding at the County line East at the center post of section 12 in Township 87 R 11 and running West to the Cedar Valley Road as runs through the lands of Edward Wood to the injury of said Woods farm see they ask therefore that in place of making a right angle due South of said Woods house, that said Road be continued due West from said angle on the quarter line till said line strikes the half mile line of sec 10. Thence due North on said line till said line strikes the Section line where said Road is now laid, You will therefore appear at the Office of the County Clerk in said County, on the 28th day of Aug. AD 1858, and qualify according to law and proceed on that day to view and make your report thereon to our said Court according to law or before the next term thereof. In your survey of this Road you will particularly describe the point of commencement & the east course & distances from some one of which you must give in your field notes, and a Plat of said Road returned with your report.
