in such cases made and provided, then this obligation to be void: otherwise, to be and remain in full force and virtue.

County, would respectfully request that so
much of the road running from the village
of Waterloo to the village of Cedar Falls as
runs from the S.E. corner of Sec. 23 in T. 9
N of Range 13. W. in said County to the S.E.
corner of Sec. 16 be discontinued and that
instead of it a road be laid in the following
route. It will commence on the road running
S. from the village of Waterloo 80 rods N. of the
S.E. corner of said Sec. 23 running thence
N. parallel with the Sec. line to a point as
near as convenient to the bank of Cedar river
thence in a north westerly course in the most
direct practicable route to the S.E. corner of
said Sec. 16. We therefore respectfully
petition that such action may be taken as will
establish the same according to law
