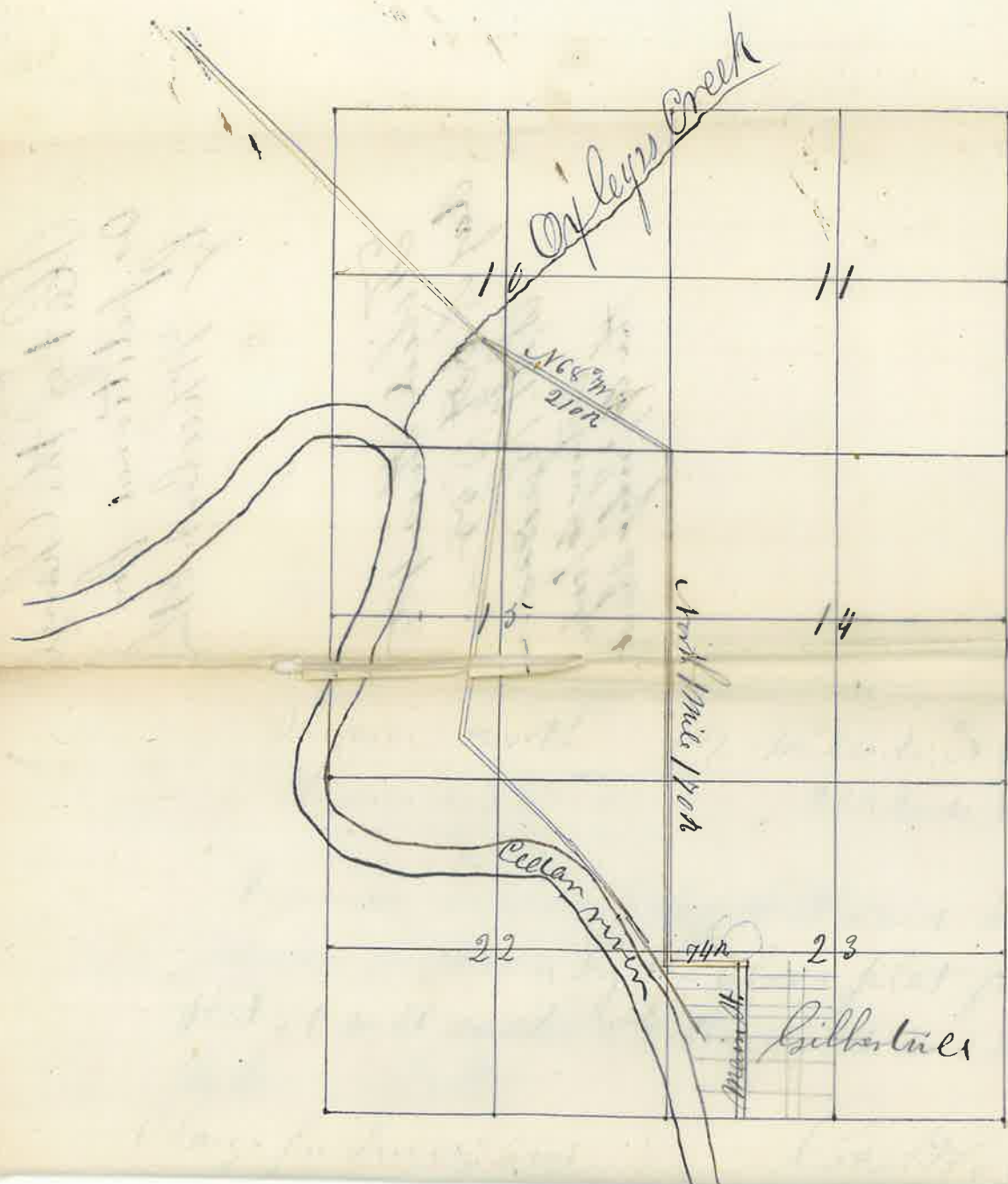

KNOW ALL MEN, by these Presents, That we, Wm. Wheeler & Son
S. J. Chamberlain
of the county of Black Hawk, and State of Iowa, are held and firmly bound unto the county
of Black Hawk in the sum of One Hundred Dollars
for the payment of which, well and truly to be made, we bind ourselves, our heirs, executors, and
ministrators, and every of them, firmly, by these presents.

The Condition of the above Obligation is such, That, whereas _____
William Wheeler & Son has this day made application, by petition, to the
County Court of said county, to appoint a commissioner to view and locate a county road, called
The Hillsboro & Poymer Creek Road

**Now, if the said road shall be established according to law, and the same become a public
highway, in accordance with the statute in such cases made and provided, then this obligation to be
void: otherwise, to be and remain in full force and virtue.**
