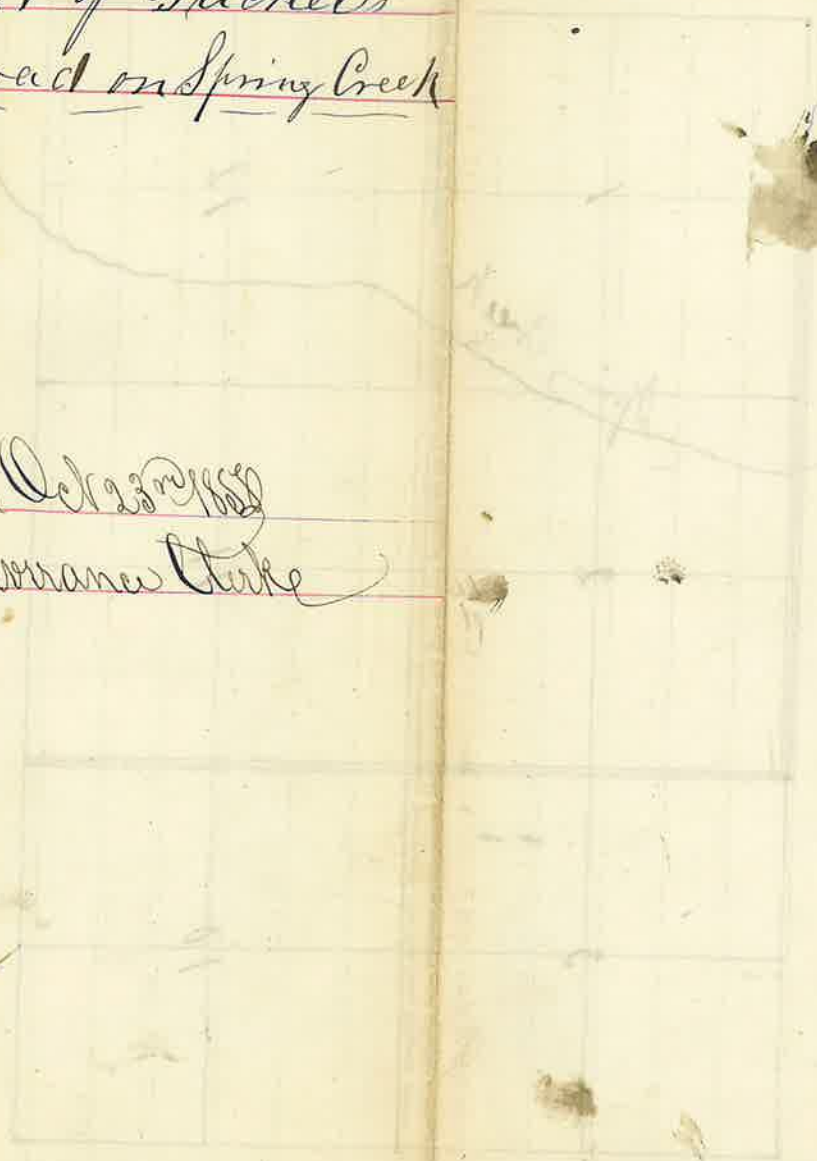

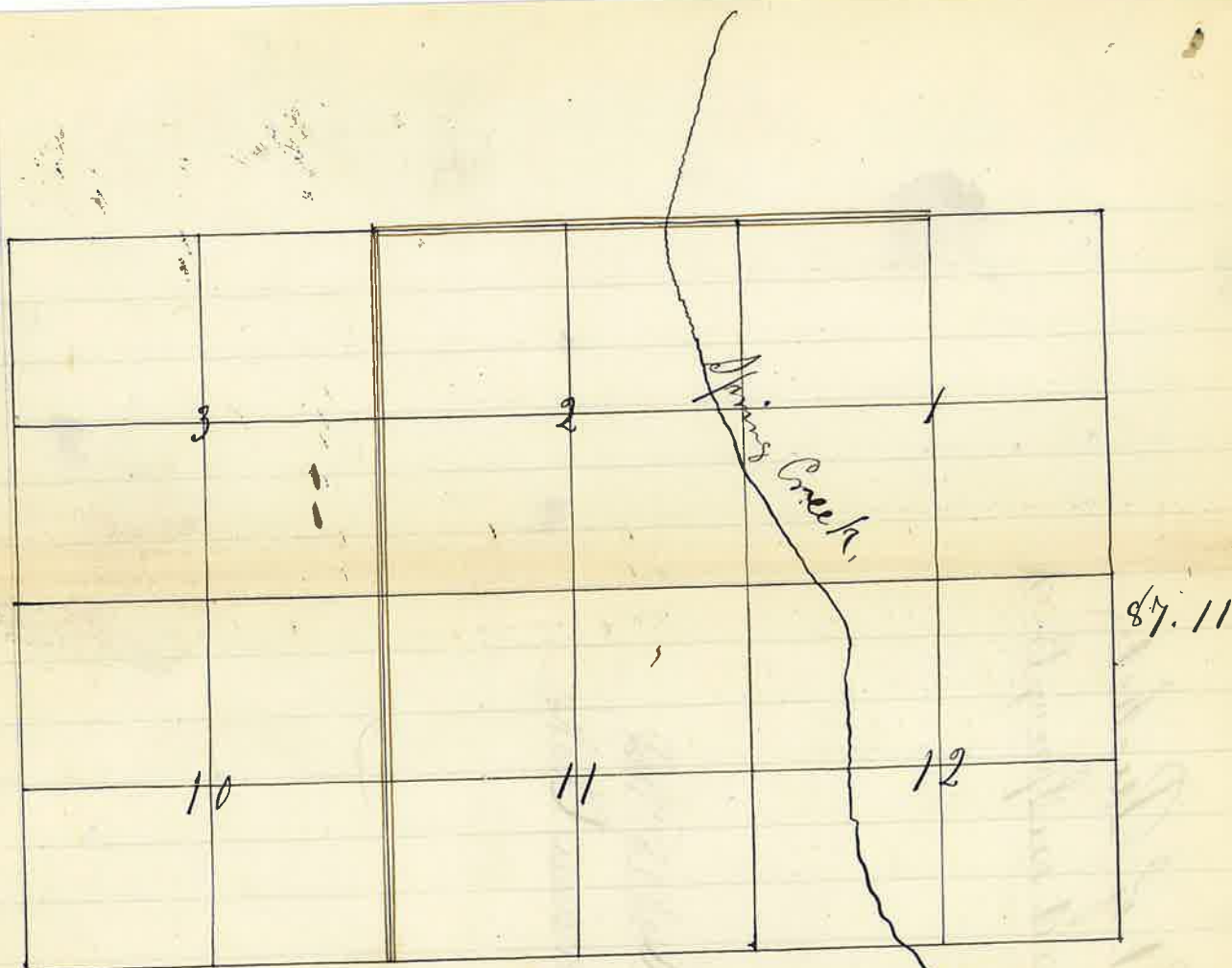

rods east of the aforesaid corner
intersecting the Lower Line Road
at said point. I grant it for
all time, and waive further damage,
so long as the same is used for a
public high way.
