Worm and others has this day made application by petition, to the
County Court of said County, to appoint a commissioner to view and locate a road, called on all section lines
in Burlington Township

NOW, If the said road shall be established according to law, and the same becomes a public highway, in accordance with the statute
in such cases made and provided, then this obligation to be void: otherwise, to be and remain in full force and virtue.

FINAL ORDER OF VACATION

WHEREAS, a public hearing on vacating of a road hereinafter described occurred pursuant to notice on March 13, 2006, and

WHEREAS, notice of said hearing was properly directed to and served upon all interested parties as required by the provisions of Chapter 306 of the Code of Iowa, and

WHEREAS, no written claim for damages was filed with the Black Hawk County Board of Supervisors, the agency in control of said road, and

WHEREAS, at the public hearing proponents and objectors to the vacating process were heard, as well as evidence received from the Black Hawk County Engineer's Office, and

WHEREAS, there being no further comments, the hearing was closed, and

WHEREAS, by Resolution, the road was vacated by a majority vote of the Board of Supervisors, now therefore

BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED that the Board of Supervisors of Black Hawk County, Iowa, hereby enters its FINAL ORDER closing and vacating a portion of North Ordway Road, a Black Hawk County Secondary Road and described as follows:

"That part of North Ordway Road, Road #281 Book B-30, from the intersection of North Ordway Road and Lester Road (being the East Quarter Corner of Section 24, Township 90 North, Range 12 West), thence South a distance of One-half mile more or less to the Intersection of North Ordway Road and East Mt. Vernon Road (being the Southeast Corner of Section 24, Township 90 North, Range 12 West), thence West along that part of East Mt. Vernon Road, Road #96 Book 1-167 for approximately 2,100 feet to a point approximately 500 feet east of the South Quarter corner of said Section 24".
