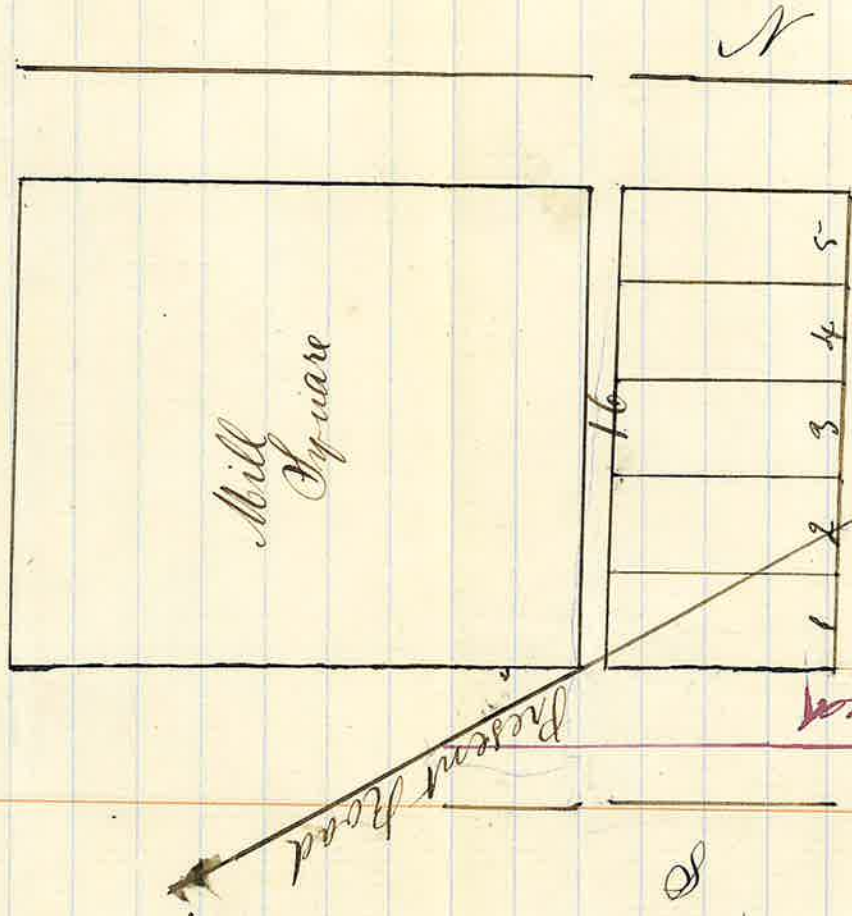

that there has been an alteration
in the road in the village of
Hudson about eight miles from
Waterloo which is on the road
from Waterloo south west towards
Steumbout Rock which makes it very
inconvenient for the people which
traverse the road to Waterloo west and
furthermore it is not on so good
ground for a road the ground
which they propose to make the alteration
is a perfect mire hole and further-
more it makes two square angles
within three hundred feet of each
other and still another where it inter-
sects the main road

We the citizens of Blackhawk County
would respectfully represent to your
Honors that the road now running through
the Town of Hudson is on a straight line
as surveyed by John Securitt and is
on good fertile ground the only bridge
through said Town is bridged near
furthermore the Commissioner that
was appointed to make the alteration
was a resident of Hudson and a
party concerned and owns property
in the Town of Hudson

We your petitioners would respectfully
represent to your Honors the necessity
of having a commissioner appointed to
see into the propriety of re locating
the road on Securitt survey as your
Honors will see the inconvenience of
the traveling community will suffer
