

Board of Supervisors of the County of Black Hawk, in the State of Iowa, met in regular meeting at the Courthouse in Waterloo, County Seat of said County, at nine o'clock a.m., pursuant to law, to the rules of said Board and to adjournment. The meeting was called to order and on roll call there were present: Lynn G. Cutler, Chairperson, Carl A. Carroll, Secretary, and Carroll T. Hayes.

Present: Lloyd W. Gallagher, Henry D. Willoughby.

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Motion was made by Neubauer, seconded by Hayes, that permission be granted to County Conservation Department to assume the responsibility of the easterly 0.28 mile of Miller Creek Road further east as follows:

A strip of land sixty-six (66) feet of even width, being thirty-three (33) feet on each side of a centerline described as follows: Commencing at a point in the Northwest Quarter of the Southwest corner of the Northwest Quarter of Township 3, Range 87 North, Range 12 West of the 5th P.M., and 44.25 feet East of the center line of the Waterloo - Cedar Falls and Northern Railroad, thence East 908.6 feet, thence North 75 degrees and 4 minutes East a distance of 586.0 feet.

Motion was made by the Conservation Department to install a controlled entranceway to the River Natural Resource Area. Motion carried.

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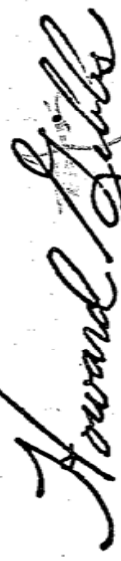
Minutes were read and approved as read.
