

Ran a right line N $\frac{1}{2}$ 35 $\frac{1}{4}$ $\frac{1}{4}$ cor. NE $\frac{1}{4}$ 35, $\frac{1}{4}$ double $\frac{1}{4}$ by dist. as per survey by John Ball 1867, dug & found only pieces of Limestone at 19", indicating stone had been broken & plowed out. So established the corner on the point & set J.C.M. 18" deep. Pieces of L.S. found were too deep to be wash, & were in black soil. Corner is too far away to make ties to local objects.
